## SUMMARY

Final City action on these uninhabited annexations have been deferred pending the adoption of agreements for the exchange of property tax revenues for these areas. The City and County staffs have been discussing this matter, and progress has been made. The staff recommends continuing this matter until July 7, 1981.

## BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Pursuant to City Council policy, these two uninhabited annexations have been processed to the final stage (adoption of agreements for the exchange of property tax revenues, and resolutions ordering annexation). As the State did not enact the anticipated legislation provid-ng for the distribution of property tax revenues when territory is annexed, the City and County staffs have made progress toward resolving this matter. The League of California Cities is seeking legislation to establish a satisfactory distribution formula.

## RECOMMENDATION

The staff recommends continuing this matter until July 7, 1981.
