SUBJECT: Amendment to the Consolidated Fee Resolution for the Addition of Fees Charged for Replacement of Lost Parking Permits

SUMMARY

This report recommends fees for refundable deposits and for replacement of lost parking permits.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

For many years City Parking Lots did not charge monthly parkers for replacing lost monthly parking permits. However, two new developments in City Parking Operations has made it necessary to charge such a replacement fee. First, when the newer garages were built the monthly parking control system required monthly parkers to use plastic, magnetically encoded cards to enter and exit from those garages. Many cards were lost and the expense of replacing them began to increase. To control the problem, a refundable deposit is now required for each card issued. The deposit is returned to the customer if and when the card is returned in an undamaged, useable condition. If the card is lost or damaged, a replacement card is available for an additional deposit. (The deposit on the lost or damaged card is waived).

Second, as the City imposed moratoriums on the sale of new monthly permits, requests for replacement of lost permits began to increase dramatically at those parking lots where paper permits are issued to monthly parkers. To counteract this problem the full monthly rate was charged for every replacement prior to the middle of the month, and one half the monthly rate was charged for replacements after the middle of the month. It has since been determined that a \$5.00 fee is more appropriate for such replacements.

FINANCIAL DATA

The number of replacements for lost permits has been low enough to be considered insignificant over the last six months. There could be an increase of requests for replacements at those lots using paper permits once the replacement fee is lowered. However, the financial impact will be insignificant.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the attached resolution, setting replacement fees and deposits for monthly parking permits, be adopted.

- (1) 25¢ each hour for first three hours, 40¢ for each hour thereafter.
- (2) Nights, special events (no time limit), and coin-operated lots.
- (3) Monthly rate for carpools 75% of regular rate.
- (4) \$26.00 for non-convention days.
- (5) \$7.00 for current residents of the Wong Center (May 1978) who own automobiles.
This rate to be phased out as residents move or dispose of their automobiles.
- (6) A \$5.00 deposit fee shall be charged for each monthly parking access card for Lots E, G, and R. This deposit shall be refundable upon return of the access card in an undamaged and useable condition, normal wear and tear excepted.
- (7) A \$5.00 fee shall be charged for each replacement for lost monthly permits at Lots A, B, H, J, K, P-1, P-2, U, V, and W.
