
Dear Mr. Connelly:

Dear Councilman Connelly:

We have completed our study as discussed with the parents, school officials and you at the January 17, 1980, meeting. The results indicate that there are only 30 points developed using the signalized location criteria which is consistent with the study conducted in the Fall of 1979. We also did an evaluation making an assumption that there was not a pedestrian traffic signal present. Using that methodology, the warrants or points come out to be in the range of 355 to 420 points. While that was an interesting exercise, the fact remains that there is a 24 hour, seven day week pedestrian traffic signal available for pedestrians or students to cross Fruitridge at any time of the day or night. There are traffic signals that can be used by pedestrians to cross Fruitridge at 65th Street, 71st Street, and Power Inn as well. These adjacent traffic signals provide additional crossing opportunities.

The Earl Warren School principal, Mrs. Ethel Breyfogle, gave us the number of students who live south of Fruitridge. There are 151 students and are grouped as follows:

Kindergarten	28 students
1st through 3rd	61 students
4th through 6th	56 students
Special Education	6 students
Total:	151 students

Our observations indicate that less than 1/3 of the students cross Fruitridge at this location. We also found that the school safety patrol seemed to lack discipline and spent more time playing rather than supervising. Based upon the concerns of parents and safety patrol coordinator regarding the loss of learning time, some reasonable courses of action might be; to have them released from school at the same time as their classmates, eliminate the school safety patrol, or have a responsible parent (or school representative) monitor

the crossing periods. We found virtually no conflicts between pedestrians and turning side street vehicles, so any concern would be with the traffic on Fruitridge.

You asked about the adult crossing guard program and the effects of Prop. 13 on it. Since this program is administered by the Police Department and since they did not get any cuts, the program remained intact, and funding was provided for the seventeen adult crossing guards. Crossing guards are used at the following locations within the city:

1. Northgate and Potomac
2. Broadway and 1st Avenue
3. Franklin and 21st Avenue (signalized)
4. Arden Way and Beaumont (signalized)
5. South Land Park and 47th Avenue
6. South Land Park and 56th Avenue
7. K Street and 25th Street
8. V Street and 10th Street
9. 43rd Avenue and 13th Street
10. Glen Ellen/Edna and 24th Street
11. Fruitridge and Helen (signalized)
12. 14th Avenue and 57th Street
13. Norwood Avenue and Lammas Avenue (signalized)
14. Del Paso Boulevard and Palo Verde (signalized)
15. South Land Park and Florin Road (signalized)
16. 21st Avenue and 58th Street (eastbound leg only)
17. Franklin Boulevard and 38th Avenue

It has been our policy to remove adult crossing guards when they are no longer needed. There have been a couple of situations where the staff decision to remove the adult crossing guard has been appealed to the City Council. As a result adult crossing guards are used there even though the staff does not feel that they are needed. A copy of the crossing guard policy is attached.

Also attached is a copy of the excerpts from the report sent to the City Council by the City Manager in May of 1978. Item 5 on page 4 mentions the elimination of all crossing guards.

Since the citizens attending the January meeting mentioned concerns about traffic conditions along Fruitridge in this area, we have looked at the total traffic situation on Fruitridge between 65th Street Expressway and Power Inn Road. Since Fruitridge Road is shown on the Sacramento Bikeway Master Plan as having an on-street route between Wallace and Florin-Perkins, we are planning to stripe Fruitridge between Wallace and Power Inn to provide a two way left turn lane with the provision for bike lanes in the future. This will require the removal of parking. The removal of parking should greatly enhance the motorists' ability to observe pedestrians and the two way left turn lane should provide a better left turn situation for turning motorists. This approach is similar to the project that is under way on Stockton Boulevard between Fruitridge and 47th Avenue/Elder Creek Road.

We also reviewed previous plans for traffic signals spaced along Fruitridge between 65th Street and Power Inn. We cannot recommend any traffic signal changes at this time. We do intend to review the visibility on the approaches to the Wallace/Lowell traffic signals as well as others along Fruitridge in the spring after the foliage has filled out. Any trees or shrubs that block the traffic signals will be trimmed accordingly. If you have any questions, please contact me.


