The Civil Service Board met in special session in its office at 7:30 P.M.

Minutes of the previous meeting were ordered approved as read.

POLICY - PROBATIONARY PERIOD  
RELIEF WORK

Interpretation of Section 1 and  
12 of Rule V of the Civil Service  
Rules and Regulations with refer-

ence to informal certifications from eligible lists for relief work and the completion of six months probationary period during employment year, was considered.

Report of the City Attorney stating that probationary appointments must be made by formal certification from eligible lists and that intermittent relief assignments could not be considered as probationary appointments thereby permitting the eligible to obtain permanent status in a classification for which there is no vacant position, was read and ordered filed.

After general discussion by members of the Board, Mr. Marty moved that effective July 1, 1947, no employee on an eligible list who is informally assigned for temporary relief work, be permitted to complete his probationary period unless formal certification is made for an existing vacant position in said classification; seconded by Mr. Root and motion carried. Mr. Deise voted "No."

There being no further business, the Board adjourned to meet again at the Call of the Chair.
