



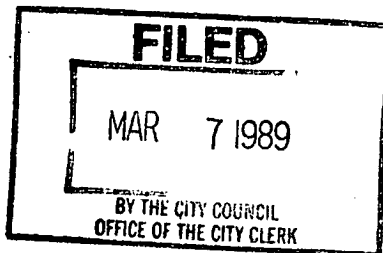

SUBJECT: Election Results - Fire Safety Member, Retirement Hearing
Commission

SUMMARY

This report will provide information regarding the election results for the Fire Safety Member on the Retirement Hearing Commission.

BACKGROUND

On February 19, 1989, Notices of Election for the Retirement Hearing Commission, Fire Safety Member, Sacramento City Employee's Retirement System, were posted at appropriate work locations in the Fire Department. Notice was given that during the period beginning February 20, 1989, and ending March 2, 1989, nominating papers were to be obtained and filed with the Office of the City Clerk. During the allowed time period, only one (1) valid nominating paper was filed with this office.

Therefore, pursuant to the provisions of City Council Resolution 77-061, "Resolution Providing Procedure for the Election of Employee Members on the Sacramento City Retirement Hearing Commission," Section 9, Richard L. Mayberry is declared elected to the position of Fire Safety Member, Retirement Hearing Commission, Sacramento City Employees' Retirement System.

It was necessary to hold this election in case the charter amendment to move Fire and Police Safety Members out of the Sacramento City Employees Retirement System (SCERS) into the Public Employees Retirement System (PERS) is not ratified by the voters in the June 6, 1989 Special Municipal Election. If this measure is approved by the voters, the Retirement Hearing Commission will be restructured accordingly to delete the Fire and Police Safety Member positions.

The procedures that were followed to conduct the election were consistent with the Sacramento City Charter and Resolution 77-061.


MBE/WBE EFFORTS
