



SUBJECT: MAJOR URBAN RESOURCE LIBRARY (MURL) AWARD

#### SUMMARY

Request approval to submit an Award application to the California State Library for \$26,630.00. Award will be used to continue the Sacramento Public Library's participation in the Major Urban Resource Library (MURL) program.

#### BACKGROUND

The Major Urban Resource Library (MURL) program is a federally funded program administered by the California State Library. MURL funds must be used to purchase or preserve material of regional interest and be made available to library systems within the regional area.

The Sacramento Public Library has been a participant in the MURL program since 1985. We have utilized MURL funds to preserve periodicals and newspapers of regional interest and increase accessibility of regional libraries (Mountain Valley Library System, North State Cooperative Library System, and Stockton-San Joaquin Public Library) to these materials. This application will allow the Library to continue this effort to build a collection of regional interest.

### FINANCIAL ANALYSIS

The award application will be for \$23,630.00. There is no matching fund requirement. The Sacramento Public Library will not contribute any funds to this project. Existing personnel will be utilized to process materials applicable to the Program.
