

ORDINANCE NO. 81-119

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON DATE OF

December 29, 1981

AN ORDINANCE DELAYING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF ORDINANCE 81-094 AND DECLARING THIS ORDINANCE TO BE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:


SECTION 1.

The provisions of Ordinance 81-094 shall take effect 90 days after the adoption of this ordinance.

SECTION 2.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure to take effect immediately. The facts constituting the emergency are that Ordinance 81-094 dissolves the Preservation Board and Architectural Review Board, and vests their present powers and duties in the newly created Design Review and Preservation Board. Pursuant to Section 27 of Ordinance 81-094, the provisions of that ordinance were to take effect ninety (90) days after its adoption, on January 4, 1982, to allow time for the appointment of the members of the Design Review and Preservation Board. It now appears that the new membership will not be appointed by January 4, 1982. It is therefore necessary that the effective date of Ordinance 81-094 be delayed, in order that the powers and duties of the Preservation Board and Architectural Review Board can continue to be duly exercised and discharged pending the appointment of members to the Design Review and Preservation Board.
