**SUBJECT:** Approval of Plans and Specifications for Stockton Boulevard - Dias Avenue Drainage

SUMMARY:

The Department of Public Works has prepared plans and specifications for the subject project. Copy of said plans and specifications has been forwarded to the City Clerk and approval is recommended.

FINANCIAL:

In F.Y. 1982-83 the City Council approved \$155,000.00 of Sewer Funds in the Department of Public Work's budget for the subject project. The total amount currently available for this project is \$138,589.22. The current estimated construction cost is \$200,000.00. The final estimate is higher than originally anticipated because of greater costs in the construction of the pumping station. It is proposed that following receipt of bids, the necessary additional funds be transferred from Cost Center 1835, William Land Park Relief Sewer, which is proposed to be defunded and has a current balance of \$129,455.00.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the plans and specifications be approved and that bids be received on August 16, 1983.
