

ORDINANCE NO. 974 , FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 555, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JUNE 16, 1932, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THE CHARGES TO BE MADE BY THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO FOR WATER SUPPLIED THEREBY; PROVIDING THAT CHARGES FOR WATER USED SHALL BE A CHARGE AND LIEN UPON THE PROPERTY ON WHICH THE WATER IS USED; REGULATING THE USE OF WATER SUPPLIED BY THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 397, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED SEPTEMBER 27TH, 1928, AND ORDINANCE NO. 478, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JULY 24TH, 1930," BY ADDING A NEW SECTION THERETO TO BE NUMBER SECTION 20a.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 555, Fourth Series, passed June 16, 1932, is hereby amended by adding a new section thereto to be numbered 20a.

VICTORY GARDEN IRRIGATION.

Section 20a: During the present national emergency caused by the war with Germany et al, free water may be furnished for new non-commercial Victory vegetable gardens for single families now paying regular water bills only, when their lots used as part of domestic enclosure do not exceed 13000 square feet in area, on additional area not exceeding 2000 square feet, adjacent to or near their homes, when water for same is taken from existing water services on their own or property adjacent to such areas. For any area greater than 2000 square feet, the initial rates already established shall prevail and shall start at the excess area over 13000 square feet; provided, however, said water must be utilized to good advantage and not allowed to waste because of lack of attention or other cause.
