SUMMARY

This report requests City Council approval to extend the date for receiving bids for the Civic Center Plaza Parking Garage project.

The same guidelines will be followed that were established in the initial adoption of plans and specifications.

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
FINANCIAL

There is no change of the financial status since the project was approved for bidding.


RECOMMENDATION
