

ORDINANCE NO. 665, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE A MOTOR DRIVEN LAWN MOWING MACHINE WITH THREE CUTTING UNITS IN OPEN MARKET WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to purchase in open market for and on behalf of the City of Sacramento a motor driven lawn mowing machine with three cutting units without first advertising for bids, such course having been recommended by the City Manager.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being as follows: the lawn area maintained by the City has been largely increased and it is necessary to obtain additional equipment to take care of same.
