

ORDINANCE NO. 655, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 18, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED SEPTEMBER 22, 1921, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR LICENSING AND REGULATING THE CARRYING ON OF CERTAIN PROFESSIONS, TRADES, CALLINGS AND OCCUPATIONS; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE, AND MAKING THIS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE, TO TAKE EFFECT OCTOBER 1ST, 1921", BY ADDING A NEW SECTION THERE-TO, TO BE NUMBERED 43 $\frac{1}{2}$, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 588, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED AUGUST 17, 1933.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 18, Fourth Series, passed September 22, 1921, is hereby amended to read as follows:-

DANCES AND DANCING.

SECTION 43 $\frac{1}{2}$. For all dances or dancing not licensed under Sections 40, 42 and 43 of this ordinance, and other than in private homes or residences; or in a dancing school or academy; or dances of a bona fide social character, to which admission is limited strictly on invitation of the person, organization, society or corporation acting as host and for which no fee, either by way of admission or in any other manner, is charged; or dances given by any bona fide fraternal, charitable, religious or benevolent society having a regular membership associated primarily for mutual social, mental and civic welfare to which admission is limited to members and guests, the revenue going therefrom to be used exclusively for the benevolent purpose of said organization; or an occasional dance at a public hall; a license fee per quarter in addition to any other license fee required by law shall be charged.

The fees where dances are held one, two or three nights per week shall be \$12.00 per quarter when floor area does not exceed 3,000 sq. ft; \$15.00 per quarter when floor area is more than 3,000 sq. ft; \$30.00 per quarter when floor area exceeds 7,000 sq. ft.


Where dances are held four nights or more per week, \$25.00 per quarter when floor area does not exceed 3,000 sq. ft; \$35.00 per quarter when floor area is more than 3,000 sq. ft., and less than 7,000 sq. ft; \$50.00 per quarter when floor area exceeds 7,000 sq. ft.

A license or a transfer thereof shall not issue for any dances, or dancing unless the person, firm, corporation, association or club applying therefor has first obtained a permit from the City Council.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 588, Fourth Series, passed August 17, 1933, is hereby repealed.
