SUMMARY

The Office of Emergency Services, requests your approval to apply for a Local Government Contingency Planning Grant not to exceed \$100,000.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Adopt the attached resolution authorizing the Office of Emergency Planning to submit application to the California Energy Commission for a Local Government Contingency Planning Grant.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The State of California Energy Commission has requested applications be submitted for completion of Local Government Contingency Planning Grant Program. A total of \$1.0 million in Petroleum Violation Escrow Account funds are available for grants. Individual grants may not exceed \$100,000. The primary purpose of the program is to assist local jurisdictions in developing or revising an energy shortage response plan. The objective is to enhance a local jurisdiction's capability to manage the impacts of a disruption to the supply and distribution systems for petroleum, natural gas and electricity.

The Office of Emergency Services, requests your approval to apply for a Local Government Contingency Planning Grant not to exceed \$100,000. The intent of the proposal will be to expand the City's existing Multi-Hazard Plan to include an energy component, resulting from a disaster situation; and to develop a stand alone plan for an energy shortage resulting from a market disruption.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

Grant funding to the City in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

The City of Sacramento recognizes the potential for energy supply disruption due to disaster or curtailment in the availability of energy. The City has a responsibility to its employees, and the citizens of the City to pursue the completion of this project and request associated funding.

MBE/WBE EFFORTS

MBE/WBE consideration will be sought where ever possible.


