**COMMENDING
PORTUGUESE COMMUNITY PARK NEIGHBORHOOD
COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, Portuguese pioneers, beginning in the 1850's, settled in large numbers in the Riverside/Pocket area and throughout the greater Sacramento area; and

WHEREAS, at what was once a vibrant and historic ethnic community in the 1880's, now sits Portuguese Community Park in the heart of the Riverside/Pocket area of Sacramento; and

WHEREAS, the park is dedicated to these Portuguese pioneers, their descendants, and to new Portuguese immigrants; and

WHEREAS, volunteer efforts by neighborhood residents and the greater Portuguese-American community provided the development of this authentic and unique park; and

WHEREAS, without these contributions of time, money, and materials valued at over \$100,000, the park would not have been possible;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the Council of the City of Sacramento that we hereby commend and recognize the greater Portuguese-American community and the neighbors of Portuguese Community Park for their generous contributions and exemplary efforts which have helped to further the common good of making our City a better place in which to live.
