

ORDINANCE NO. 686, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING OUT OF THE REVENUES OF THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1936, THE AMOUNTS NECESSARY TO MEET THE EXPENDITURE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CITY BASED ON THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1936, SUBMITTED BY THE CITY MANAGER AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the revenues of the fiscal year ending December 31, 1936, amounts sufficient to meet the expenditure requirements of the City, including salaries as set forth therein, based on the budget for the fiscal year ending December 31, 1936, submitted by the City Manager and as determined and adopted by the Council.

SECTION 2. This ordinance, in so far as it refers to salaries, supersedes, for the fiscal year of 1936, all salary ordinances now in force.

SECTION 3. This ordinance, being one appropriating money, is hereby made an emergency measure as provided by the Charter.
