SUBJECT: Agreement with Sacramento City Unified School District for
Preparation and Delivery of Meals for Summer Food Service Program

SUMMARY

This report recommends that the City Manager be authorized to sign an agreement with the Sacramento City Unified School District for the preparation and delivery of meals for the Summer Food Service Program to be administered by the Department of Parks and Community Services.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On December 4, 1987, the City Council authorized the Department of Parks and Community Services to administer and operate the 1988 Summer Food Service Program for low income children in the City and County of Sacramento through a reimbursement program with the United States Department of Agriculture.

Negotiations have been completed for the sixth year with the Sacramento City Unified School District to prepare and deliver breakfasts, lunches, and snacks for the program under a contractual agreement with the City. The Recreation Division of the Department of Parks and Community Services will administer and supervise the program and coordinate all aspects of the operation. The contract stipulates the terms and conditions of the agreement and provides that the City will pay the District \$.92 per breakfast, \$1.60 per lunch, and \$.43 per snack delivered. Terms of the contract provide that either agency may cancel the agreement with thirty (30) days' notice.

FINANCIAL DATA

The costs associated with the program, including administration, site monitoring, food preparation, and delivery, will be reimbursed from the United States Department of Agriculture and from support from the City and County of Sacramento. Total program costs are estimated at \$264,959. Maximum financial support from the City and County will be \$5,000 each. The City's share has been budgeted in the 1988-89 Recreation Division budget.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council, by resolution, authorize and direct the City Manager to sign an agreement with the Sacramento City Unified School District for the preparation and delivery of meals for the 1988 Summer Food Service Program.
