

ORDINANCE NO. 1049, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1014, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JULY 14, 1944, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING OUT OF THE REVENUES OF THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1944, THE AMOUNTS NECESSARY TO MEET THE EXPENDITURE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CITY BASED ON THE BUDGET AS AMENDED FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1944," BY ADDING A NEW SECTION THERETO, TO BE NUMBERED SECTION 10, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: Ordinance No. 1014, Fourth Series, passed July 14, 1944, is hereby amended by adding a new section thereto to be numbered Section 10:

SECTION 10: There is hereby appropriated out of the available revenues, not included in the annual 1944-45 budget, the sum of \$19,547.25 to be used for the purchase of One (1) 85' Cab over Engine Aerial Ladder Truck for the Fire Department.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being that the immediate purchase of this equipment is necessary to replace similar equipment in the Oak Park District which has been in service since 1916.
