**RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING
HARVEY E. THOMPSON**

IT IS HEREBY NOTED that the people of the City of Sacramento suffered a great loss in the passing of Dr. Harvey E. Thompson on the 13th day of November, 1986 at the age of 45 in Sacramento, California.

WHEREAS, Dr. Thompson has served this community as a physician and as a humanitarian with competence and dedication; and,

WHEREAS, Dr. Thompson was tireless in his efforts to assist in the treatment of and dissemination of information regarding the acquired immune deficiency syndrome; and,

WHEREAS, Dr. Thompson was a founding medical director of the Sacramento AIDS Foundation and published a nationally syndicated column on gay health care; and,

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to publicly recognize the contributions of Dr. Harvey E. Thompson to our community and in so doing express its' condolences to his family and friends;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that this Resoltuion be entered with the minutes of this meeting, in addition to which, this meeting shall be adjourned in respect for the memory of Dr. Harvy E. Thompson;
