SUBJECT: Ground Water Quality Monitoring Wells (PN:YA41) - Contract Award

SUMMARY

This project has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and contract award is recommended.

BACKGROUND

This project will construct seven new water quality monitoring wells at the active and inactive landfill sites between 23rd Street and the Southern Pacific Railroad right-of-way.

On September 23, 1986 the City Council approved the plans and specifications for this project. Bids were received and opened by the City Clerk on October 14, 1986. The bids received were:

Layne Western Co., Inc.	\$18,330.00
Lester A. Bugbee	\$23,290.81

The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$27,000. The estimated project completion date is December 15, 1986.

FINANCIAL

Sufficient funds are available for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$24,000. The current budget is \$80,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from solid waste funds.




