SUBJECT: Traffic Signals and Improvements at San Juan Road and
Bridgefords Drive (PN:SG11) - Project Approval and Bid
Advertisement

SUMMARY

Plans and specifications for this project have been prepared. Approval of the plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids is recommended.

BACKGROUND

This project will install traffic signals at the intersection of San Juan Road and Bridgefords Drive. Also included will be the installation of street lights, pedestrian actuated walk lights and handicap ramps. The completion of the project will improve vehicular flow and improve safety for both vehicles and pedestrians.

This will be the fifth set of traffic signals installed using Measure A (One Half Cent Sales Tax Program) funds.

A Categorical Exemption for this project was filed with the County Clerk of the County of Sacramento on September 7, 1990. The engineer's estimated construction cost is \$108,000.

FINANCIAL DATA

Sufficient funds are available for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$142,800. The current budget is \$ 150,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from the Sacramento Transportation Sales Tax (201). The funds available for this project amount to \$146,000, as of September 6, 1990.

A non-refundable fee of \$20.00 will be charged for each set of plans and specifications to cover reproduction costs.

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POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

This action is consistent with Chapter 58, Article III, Section 58.301 of the City Code concerning advertisement for bids.

MBE/WBE EFFORTS

Plans and specifications will be sent to nineteen (19) plan rooms and construction services organizations for publication and use by the construction industry of Northern California. There are four (4) organizations on the distribution list that are directly involved with the MBE/WBE contractors.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council approve the plans and specifications for this project and authorize the City Clerk to advertise for bids to be received on October 16, 1990.

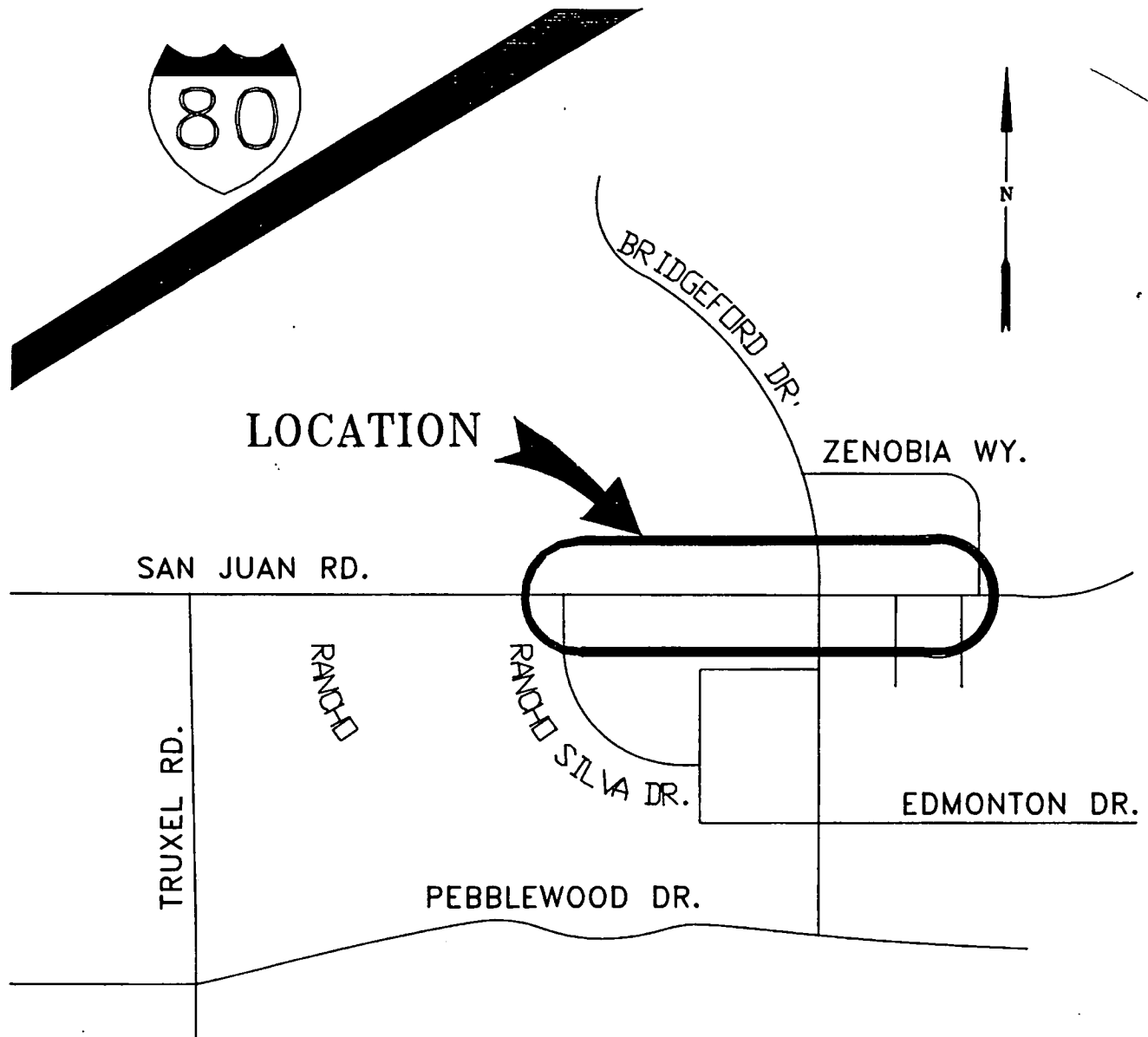
