SUBJECT: Resurfacing of State Highway 160 from C Street to F Street

and D Street to V Street

# SUMMARY:

This report recommends that approval be given for financing the resurfacing of State Highway 160 from C Street to F Street on 12th Street and portions of 16th Street from D Street to V Street. Approval of the specifications for the project is recommended.

### BACKGROUND:

Portions of the roadway of State Highway 160, where City streets are utilized, need to be resurfaced. Specifications have been prepared for the project but no plans are required. The areas to be resurfaced will be cold planed and a blanket of asphaltic concrete laid on top.

#### FINANCIAL DATA:

It is estimated that the project will cost \$74,900.00. The State Department of Transportation will reimburse the City for the cost of the resurfacing project up to that amount. It is proposed that funding for the project be provided from the Administrative Contingency Fund, which would be reimbursed upon payment by the State. A recommendation for the transfering of funds will be made following receipt of bids.

#### RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the Budget and Finance Committee recommend to the full City Council that:

- Financing for the subject project be approved from the Administrative Contingency Fund, and
- 2. The specifications be approved and bids be received on September 1, 1981.
