SUBJECT: Replacement of sewer line in G-H Alley

between 10th & 11th Streets

SUMMARY:

This report recommends that approval be given for financing the replacement of a sewer line in the G-H Alley between 10th & 11th Streets.

BACKGROUND:

As part of a development project in the subject area, the developer is replacing a majority of the existing alley between 10th & 11th Streets. Because of the deteriorated condition of the existing sewer line in said alley, it is in the City's interest to replace the sewer line as part of the alley reconstruction project.

FINANCIAL DATA:

It is estimated the project will cost approximately \$26,000.00. It is proposed that funding be provided from the Sewer Fund balance. An appropriation of funds will be requested upon approval of a reimbursement agreement with the developer.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the Budget and Finance Committee recommend to the full City Council that financing be approved for the subject project from the Sewer Fund balance.
