SUBJECT: Evergreen Street Widening - Frienza Avenue to Calvados Avenue  
(C.C. 9674) - Fund Transfer and Contract Award

### SUMMARY

This project has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and contract award is recommended.

### BACKGROUND

On May 14, 1985, the City Council approved plans and specifications for the Evergreen Street Widening - Frienza Avenue to Calvados Avenue and bids were received and opened by the City Clerk in the Council Chambers on June 4, 1985. Bids received are as follows:

Teichert Construction	\$127,178.45
Granite Construction Company	\$130,296.00
Keyava Construction	\$140,127.00
R.C. Collet, Inc.	\$144,525.00

The estimated date for completion of the project is October 15, 1985.

### FINANCIAL

The City Council has approved \$115,000 in the Department of Public Works budget from Major Street Construction funds for this project. The amount currently available for the project is \$107,000. It is proposed that an additional \$30,000 be transferred from the Major Street Contingency Fund (account No. 2-09) to cover the cost of construction for this project. The Engineer's estimated construction cost was \$106,000.



RECOMMENDATION




