SUBJECT: Mechanical Trash Removal Equipment for Drainage Sump
132 (PN:XD31) - Approval of Consultant Services
Agreement

SUMMARY

A Consultant Services Agreement has been negotiated with Ensign and Buckley Consulting Engineers to provide engineering design services for mechanical trash removal equipment at Sump 132. Approval of the agreement is recommended.

BACKGROUND

Drainage Sump 132 is located in the Pocket Area (see attached location map) and pumps storm water into the Sacramento River.

The Flood Control and Sewer Division has identified this as a priority project in their efforts to increase efficiency of maintenance operations by providing a more automated and efficient system. The consultant firm of Ensign and Buckley has been selected to perform design services for the subject project.

FINANCIAL

This project is included in the Fiscal Year 1989-1990 Capitol Improvement Budget (PN:XD31) and has a current fund balance of \$700,000 from the Pocket Area Trunk-Sewer Maintenance (Fund 240). The "not to exceed" limit for the proposed agreement is \$61,748.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

Ensign and Buckley was selected in conformance with existing consultant selection procedures. Requests for proposals were submitted to seventeen (17) Engineering firms. Proposals were received from seven (7) firms.



It is recommended that the City Council approve the subject Consultant Services Agreement by adoption of the attached resolution.



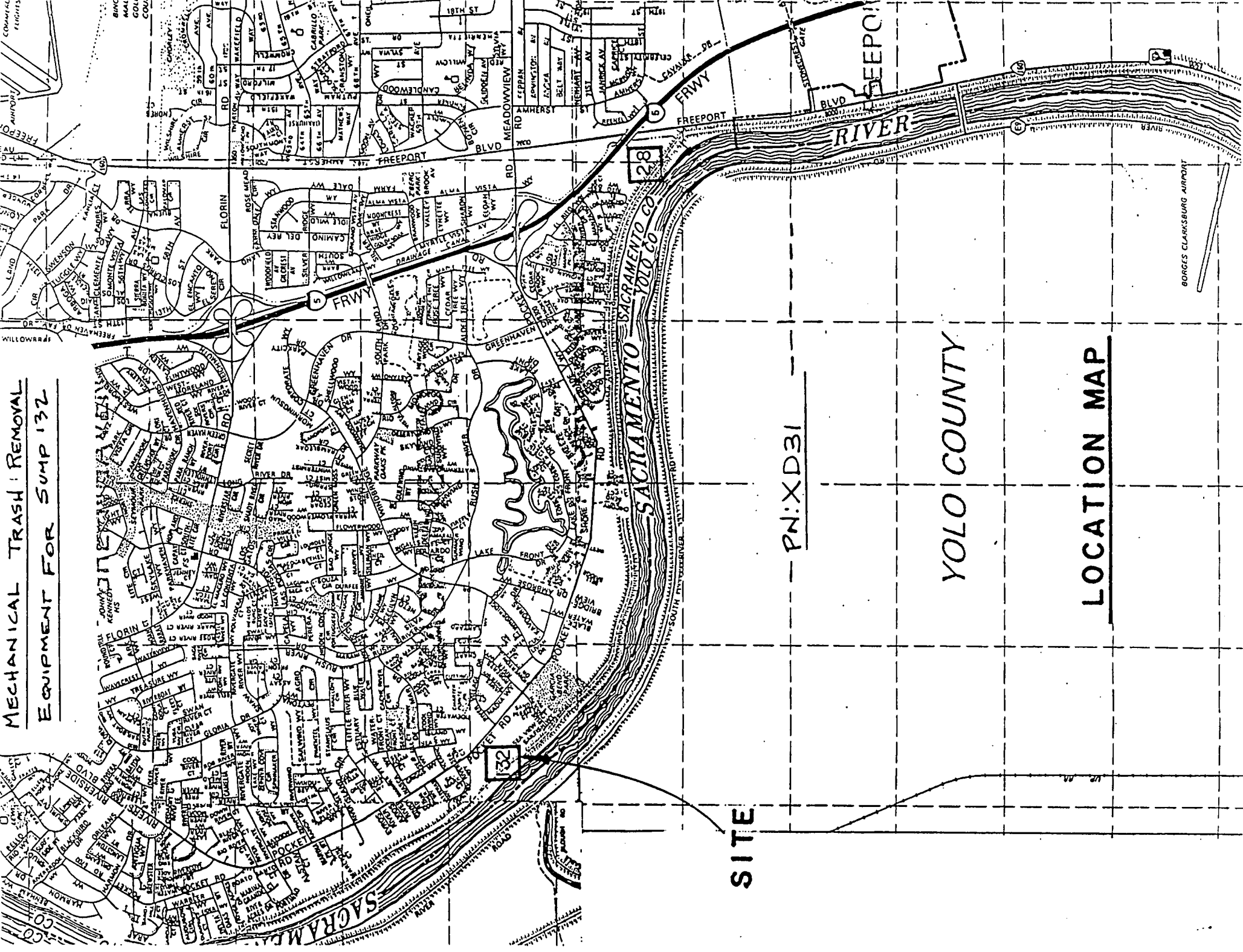
