VACATING PUBLIC EASEMENT PURSUANT TO THE STREET VACATION ACT OF 1941 OF STREETS AND HIGHWAYS CODE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City Council of the City of Sacramento requesting the vacation of the public street hereinafter described by vacating R Street from Front Street to South Levee Road, in the City of Sacramento according to the official map or plat thereof;

WHEREAS, this Council did fix the 15th day of January, 1980, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P. M. of said day, in the Council Chambers of the City Council of the City of Sacramento in the City Hall on I Street between 9th and 10th Streets of said City, as the time and place for hearing said petition and did give due notice thereof as required pursuant to the Street Vacation Act of 1941 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, the said City Council has adopted a Resolution of Intention to vacate the Street hereinafter described pursuant to Resolution of Intention No. 5059, adopted by the City Council on December 26th, 1979; and

WHEREAS, said City Council did hear the evidence offered by any and all parties interested in said petition; and

WHEREAS, said vacation is declared after due proceedings had therefor according to law and the finding by the City Council which is hereby made, that said Street is unnecessary for present or prospective use.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:



That this Council has heretofore adopted it's Engineer's to to Report and the same is attached hereto and marked Exhibit "A" to and incorporated by reference herein.

That the hereinafter described public easement in the City $^{\rm i}$ of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, be, and $^{\rm t}$ the same is hereby ordered vacated:

R Street from the West line of Front Street, as established to by the California Department of Transportation, to the East incline of South Levee Road, as shown on the plat of Brannan's California Addition to Sacramento, filed in the office of the Recorder of Sacramento County in Book 1 of Maps, Map No. 13. RESERVING HOWEVER, the right of entry to repair, maintain and construct aerial or underground power facilities now in place in the East 20 feet of said Street, or which from time to time may be placed therein. All proceedings in connection with the aforesaid abandonment are to be taken subject to such reserve vations and exceptions.



RESOLUTION OF INTENTION

NO. 5059

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the City Council of the City of Sacramento, the public interest and convenience require the abandonment of the following described public right of way as provided under the Street Vacation Act of 1941, Streets and Highways Code of the State of California;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Sacramento hereby declares its intention to abandon and vacate the following described public right of way in the City of Sacramento described as follows:

R Street from the West line of Front Street, as established by the California Department of Transportation, to the East line of South Levee Road, as shown on the plat of Brannan's Addition to Sacramento, filed in the office of the Recorder of Sacramento of Sacramento County in Book l of Maps, Map No. 13. RESERVING HOWEVER, the right of entry to repair, maintain and construct aerial or underground power facilities now in place in said Alley, or which from time to time may be placed therein. All proceedings in connection with the aforesaid abandonment are to be taken subject to such reservations and exceptions.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that on the 15th day of January, 1980, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P. M. in the Council Chambers of the City Council of the City of Sacramento, on I Street between 9th and 10th Streets in said City, be, and the same is hereby fixed as the time and place for the hearing on the proposed abandonment of said public right of way.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk be directed to publish notice of hearing of the proposed abandonment of said public right of way in the Sacramento Union, a daily newspaper, as required by law, and that said notice be posted along the right of way to be abandoned in accordance with the provisions of the Street Vacation Act of 1941, Sections 8300 to 8324, Streets and Highways Code of the State of California.
