**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO  
IN FAVOR OF A STATEWIDE BAN ON THE SALE  
AND POSSESSION OF SEMI-AUTOMATIC,  
MILITARY-TYPE ASSAULT WEAPONS**

**WHEREAS,** it is the policy of the City of Sacramento to support efforts to promote public safety; and

**WHEREAS,** due to their high rate of fire, semi-automatic, military-type assault weapons and related weapons pose an even greater danger to the public safety than other kinds of firearms which are currently regulated under state law; and

**WHEREAS,** semi-automatic, military-type assault weapons are not subject to State of California licensing procedures and application requirements for the sale and purchase of firearms capable of being concealed on the person and are as easy to purchase as other firearms under current state law; and

**WHEREAS,** the use of semi-automatic, military-type assault weapons by drug dealers and others has increased dramatically in California and nationwide during the past several years and has resulted in numerous deaths and injuries; and

**WHEREAS,** very recently there were five children killed and over thirty other children were wounded on a Stockton schoolyard as a result of shots fired by a deranged man firing an AK-47 semi-automatic rifle;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and the Council of the City of Sacramento, that we hereby affirm the support for legislation banning the sale and possession of semi-automatic, military-type assault weapons.
