SUBJECT: Request for Resolution approving employment contracts with Mary E. Bass, Raleigh W. Elliott, R. D. Hendricks, Mark R. Parker, Jean Eric Noblet and Neal G. Denton for services to be rendered to the Mountain-Valley Library System.

SUMMARY

The City-County Librarian requests approval by the City Council of the execution of employment agreements between the City of Sacramento, acting on behalf of the Mountain-Valley Library System, and Mary E. Bass, Library Assistant; Raleigh W. Elliott, Library Technician; R. D. Hendricks, Driver-Deliveryman; Mark R. Parker, Coordinator-Analyst; Jean Eric Noblet and Neal G. Denton, Data Entry Operators. City Council action is required to make these agreements binding.

BACKGROUND

The Mountain-Valley Library System is a consortium of independent city, county, college, university and special libraries who have joined to form a cooperative network, providing interlibrary loans, reference back-up, communications and delivery service for a nine-county area in the state of California.

The agreements reflect the following adjustments in salaries as voted by the Executive Council of the Mountain-Valley Library System at their regularly scheduled meeting on May 9, 1985 in Rocklin, California.

1. A 4% Cost of living increase for Mary E. Bass and R. D. Hendricks. Ms Bass will earn \$16,541 annually, or \$7.953 per hour. Mr. Hendricks will earn \$19,328 annually, or \$9.293 per hour.
2. A 5% Merit step increase for Raleigh Elliot in addition to a 4% cost of living increase. Mr. Elliott will earn \$19,497 annually, or \$9.374 per hour.
3. A 5% merit step increase for Mark R. Parker. Mr. Parker will earn \$38,187 annually, or \$18.359 per hour.
4. A 5% merit increase for Neal G. Denton and Jean Eric Noblet. Mr. Denton and Mr. Noblet will earn \$7.35 per hour and up to \$3,822 per year. Both employees work ten (10) hours per week.

All increases in salary are to be effective July 1, 1985.

FINANCIAL DATA

The City of Sacramento, as fiscal agent for the Mountain-Valley Library System, administers funds received pursuant to standard agreements between the State Department of Education, the State Library and the City of Sacramento. There is no obligation on the part of City of Sacramento to continue personnel employed with project funds after these funds have been expended.


VOTE AND RECOMMENDATION OF MVLS EXECUTIVE COUNCIL

RECOMMENDATION


