Description/Analysis

Issue Detail: The new 2,150 seat, live music venue, Channel 24, is located at 1800 24th Street and is scheduled to open April 24th. Certain residential streets within an approximate four-block radius of the new Channel 24 live music venue (See Exhibit A) are currently regulated with residential permit parking restrictions of “Two-Hour Parking 8:00 am to 10:00 pm Except Saturdays and Sundays.” Concerned about the impact to on-street parking by attendees of Channel 24, residents within the proposed areas have requested the current parking restrictions be changed to “One-Hour Parking, 8:00 am to 12:00 am Except with Permit” or “No Parking 8:00 am to 12:00 am Except with Permit.” These proposed changes will ensure residents will continue to have safe and convenient parking near their homes.

Policy Considerations: The recommendations in the report are in accordance with 1) City Code Section 10.48.040 Designation of Residential Permit Parking Areas; and 2) the Central City Parking Master Plan goal to make parking safe, secure, attractive and convenient.

Economic Impacts: None.

Environmental Considerations: The current proposal involves restrictions to parking. The proposal is not a “project” in accordance with Section 15378 of the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines. The implementation of these parking restrictions does not have the potential for resulting in either direct or indirect physical changes in the environment. Therefore, as determined by the City’s Environmental Services Planning Manager, no environmental review is necessary.

Sustainability: This action supports the City of Sacramento’s sustainability goals to improve and optimize the transportation infrastructure.

Commission/Committee Action: None.

Rationale for Recommendation: Certain streets (see Exhibit A) within an approximate four-block radius of the new live music venue, Channel 24 are currently regulated with residential permit parking restrictions of “Two-Hour Parking 8:00 am to 10:00 pm Except Saturdays and Sundays.” These existing restrictions allow the possibility of Channel 24 attendees parking in these residential parking spaces and preventing residents from parking near their homes. The proposed modifications to the current parking restrictions will ensure residents have safe and convenient parking near their homes.

Financial Considerations: The cost to implement the recommended parking restrictions is estimated to be \$14,000. These expenses will be charged to the Department of Public Works, Parking Services Division’s Fiscal Year (FY) 2024/25 operating budget (General Fund, Fund 1001). Sufficient funds are available in the Department of Public Works FY2024/25 operating budget (General Fund, Fund 1001) to implement the recommended parking regulations.

PROPOSED MODIFICATIONS TO RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING RESTRICTIONS ADJACENT TO CHANNEL 24 LIVE MUSIC VENUE

BACKGROUND

- A. The 2,150 seat, live music venue, Channel 24, is located at 1800 24th Street and scheduled to open April 24, 2025.
- B. Certain residential streets within an approximate four-block radius of the new Channel 24 live music venue (See Exhibit A) are currently regulated with residential permit parking restrictions of “Two-Hour Parking 8:00 am to 10:00 pm Except Saturdays and Sundays.”
- C. Concerned about the impact to on-street parking by attendees of Channel 24, residents within the proposed areas have requested the current parking restrictions be changed to “One-Hour Parking, 8:00 am to 12:00 am Except with Permit” or “No Parking 8:00 am to 12:00 am Except with Permit.” These proposed changes will ensure residents will continue to have safe and convenient parking near their homes.
- D. Letters outlining the proposed restrictions were mailed to all affected property owners on 3/10/2025.
- E. There is sufficient funding within the Parking Services Division’s Fiscal Year (FY)2024/25 operating budget to implement the recommended parking regulations.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The residential permit parking sections of the following streets will be regulated with “One-Hour Parking, 8:00 am to 12:00 am Except with Permit”

- 20th Street, both sides, from ~~N-P~~ Street to V Street
- 21st Street, both sides, from ~~N-P~~ Street to V Street
- 22nd Street, both sides, from ~~N-P~~ Street to V Street
- 23rd Street, both sides, from ~~N-P~~ Street to V Street
- 24th Street, both sides, from ~~N-P~~ Street to V Street
- 25th Street, both sides, from ~~N-P~~ Street to V Street
- ~~26th Street, both sides, from N Street to O Street~~

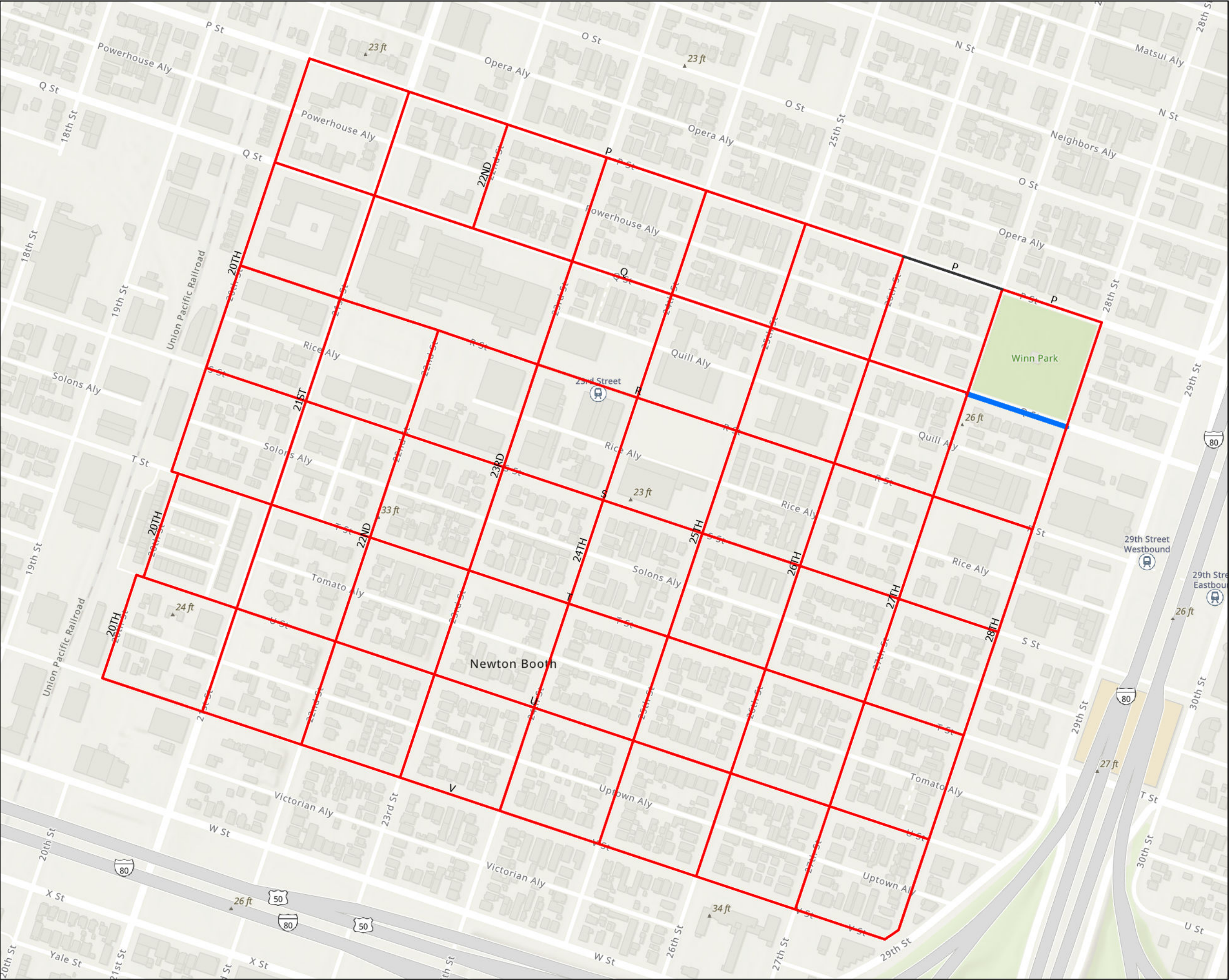
- 26th Street, both sides, from P Street to V Street
- ~~27th Street, both sides, from N Street to O Street~~
- 27th Street, both sides, from P Street to V Street
- 28th Street, both sides, from ~~N~~P Street to V Street
- ~~N Street, both sides, from 20th Street to 28th Street~~
- ~~O Street, both sides, from 20th Street to 26th Street~~
- ~~O Street, both sides, from 27th Street to 28th Street~~
- P Street, both sides, from 20th Street to 26th Street
- P Street, both sides, from 27th Street to 28th Street
- Q Street, north side, from 20th Street to 28th Street
- Q Street, south side, from 20th Street to 27th Street
- R Street, both sides, from 20th Street to 28th Street

- U Street, both sides, from 20th Street to 28th Street
- V Street, both sides, from 20th Street to 28th Street

Section 2. The following street will be regulated with “No Parking 8:00 am to 12:00 am Except with Permit”

- Q Street, south side, from 27th to 28th Street

Proposed Parking Restrictions

- 1 Hour Parking 8am-12am, except with residential permit
- No Parking 8am-12am, except with residential permit. Q Street, south side only 27th St - 28th St
- No changes to existing residential restrictions, owners have opted out.

Only current Residential Parking Restrictions in the marked area will be affected. These restrictions will be enforced seven days a week except with residential parking permit.
