SUBJECT: Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission - Maintenance  
Costs for Art in Public Places Collection

SUMMARY

This report is for information only on costs related to maintenance for the City's Art in Public Places collection.

BACKGROUND

Staff is currently collecting, evaluating, photographing and writing condition reports on the City's CETA art collection. The evaluation indicates that several of the pieces need to be reframed. In addition, it was recommended by the evaluation panel that some of the artwork be deaccessioned. It is not known at this time what the costs will be to complete this task. Staff is currently refining the cost estimates for this project. Staff has completed budgets for FY 1989-90 and 1990-91 which have funds to cover these costs.

The largest APP maintenance project to date is the repair of the Fred Ball mural on Macy's Garage. This piece is owned by the SHRA and they will pay for its repair (approximately \$29,000 - \$30,000). In the past, a consultant has been hired to maintain our entire APP collection. The consultant moves artwork, reframes artwork, installs plaques, and removes graffiti from artwork. The contracts for his services have been as follows:

October 1986 - October 1987.....	\$1,000
December 1987 - December 1988.....	\$1,000
April 1989 - April 1990.....	\$2,000
TOTAL.....	\$4,000
