

1. Bid must be submitted on this printed form and sealed in the envelope supplied.
2. All bids shall be clearly and distinctly written without erasure or interlineation, and properly signed by an authorized party, who shall indicate the capacity in which the signature is executed.
3. Alternate bids are invalid unless invited and covered by the specifications.
4. If required, a bid bond in the amount stated on the front of this form must accompany this bid. Payment must be made by surety bond or in a form approved by the City Attorney.
5. All bids must be delivered to the designated recipient not later than the time specified on the front of this form.
6. No bidder shall be interested in more than one bid as provided by City Code Section 57.302(d).
7. The right to reject any and or all bids is reserved by the City, in its absolute discretion.
8. The City reserves the right to waive any informalities or minor irregularities in connection with bids received.
9. All provisions of Chapter 57 of the City Code are applicable to any bid submitted or contract awarded pursuant thereto.
10. If equipment is bid, it is to be newest and latest model in current production. Used, remanufactured, shopworn, demonstrator, prototype or discontinued models are not acceptable unless otherwise stipulated.

The "lowest responsible bidder" is defined as follows:

In addition to price in determining the lowest responsible bidder under the provisions of this chapter, consideration shall be given to: (i) the quality and performance of the supplies to be provided by the bidder; (ii) the ability, capacity and skill of the bidder to perform the contract or effectuate the transaction; (iii) the ability of the bidder to perform the contract or effectuate the transaction within the time specified, without delay; (iv) the character, integrity, reputation, judgement, experience and efficiency of the bidder; (v) the quality of bidder's performance on previous purchases by, or contracts with, the City; and (vi) the ability of the bidder to provide future maintenance, repair parts and services for the supplies provided. INSURANCE PROVISIONS

1. Independent Contractor. At all times during the term of this Contract, Contractor shall be an independent Contractor and shall not be an employee of the City. City shall have the right to control Contractor only insofar as the results of Contractor's services rendered pursuant to this Contract; however, City shall not have the right to control the means by which Contractor accomplishes services rendered pursuant to this Contract.

2. Licenses; Permits; Etc. Contractor represents and warrants to City that he has all licenses, permits, qualifications and approvals of whatsoever nature which are legally required for Contractor to practice his profession. Contractor represents and warrants to City that Contractor shall, at his sole cost and expense, keep in effect at all times during the term of this Contract any licenses, permits, and approvals which are legally required for Contractor to practice his profession.

3. Insurance.

(a) Comprehensive Auto and General Liability. During the term of the Contract, Contractor shall maintain in full force and effect a comprehensive auto and general liability insurance in an amount of no less than \$1,000,000 single limit per occurrence, issued by an admitted insurer or insurers as defined by the California Insurance Code, providing that the City of Sacramento, its officers, employees and agents are to be named as additional insureds under the policy, and the policy shall stipulate that his insurance effected by the City or other named insured will be called on to contribute to a loss covered thereunder.

(b) Worker's Compensation. During the term of this Contract, Contractor shall fully comply with the terms of the law of California concerning workman's compensation. Said compliance shall include, but not be limited to, maintaining in full force and effect one or more policies of insurance insuring against any liability Contractor may have for workman's compensation.

(c) Certificate of Insurance. The Contractor will have a standard "Certificate of Insurance" completed prior to engaging in any operation or activity set forth in this contract/agreement. Said policies shall provide that no cancellation, change in coverage, or expiration by the insurance company or the insured shall occur during the term of this contract, without 30 days written notice to the City prior to the effective date of such cancellation or change in coverage.

INSURANCE PROVISIONS - Continued

4. Contractor Not Agent. Except as City may specify in writing, Contractor shall have no authority, express or implied, to act on behalf of City in any capacity whatsoever as an agent. Contractor shall have no authority, express or implied, pursuant to this Contract to bind City to any obligation whatsoever.

5. Assignment Prohibited. No party to this Contract may assign any right or obligation pursuant to this Contract. Any attempted or purported assignment of any right or obligation pursuant to this Contract shall be void and of no effect.

6. Hold Harmless Agreement. Contractor hereby agrees to, and shall, fully indemnify, hold harmless and defend City, its elective and appointive boards, commissions, officers, agents and employees from all claims, demands or liability for any injury to persons or property occurring by reason of anything done or omitted to be done in performing the Work under the Contract, whether such actions or omissions be by Contractor or by any of Contractor's subcontractors, or by any persons or person directly or indirectly employed by, or acting as agent for, Contractor or any of Contractor's subcontractors. The Contractor agrees to, and shall defend City and its elective and appointive boards, commissions, officers, agents and employees from any suits or actions at law or in equity arising by reason of any of the aforesaid actions or omissions provided as follows:

- a. That City does not, and shall not, waive any rights against Contractor which it may have by reason of the aforesaid hold harmless agreement, because of the acceptance by City, or the deposit with City by Contractor, or any of the insurance policies described in this Agreement.
- b. That the aforesaid hold harmless agreement shall apply to all damages and claims for damages of every kind suffered, or alleged to have been suffered, by reason of any of the aforesaid actions or omissions, regardless of whether City has prepared, supplied, or approved of plans and/or specifications for the Work under the Contract, or regardless of whether any insurance policies shall have been determined to be applicable to any of such damages or claims for damages. The Contractor's obligation to indemnify City shall be effective even if City is guilty of negligence or misconduct that contributes to the damages claimed. This indemnity will not extend to claims, demands, liability or expense arising out of the sole negligence or willful misconduct of City.

SPECIFICATIONS FOR TREE TRIMMING/TREE REMOVAL SERVICES

Scope

Work to be done consists of complete general trimming/and or removal of various trees from various locations in the City of Sacramento as directed by the Director of Parks and Community Services or his designated representative, hereinafter called the Tree Inspector.

This work is to be performed by a tree service state licensed contractor, licensed and insured to do business in the City of Sacramento. The work to be done will consist of removal of trees, trimming of trees, hauling and disposal of debris, and where necessary, repair or replacement to original condition of any damaged public or private property. Chipped waste material shall be disposed of at a location designated by the City at contractor's expense. Logs, brush and other debris may be dumped at a separate location as designated by the City at contractor's expense. **NO FIREWOOD WILL BE GIVEN TO ANYONE.**

Elm wood and debris shall be handled in accordance with State Dutch Elm Disease (DED) quarantine mandates. Contractors will be provided with DED training by the City prior to start of contract work. All elm debris (logs and brush) shall be disposed of at a site approved by the City and disposal costs are the contractors responsibility.

Contractor shall be aware of and shall comply with City Ordinances governing tree trimming work and traffic control regulations during work. Contractor shall furnish all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to perform the work described herein in strict accordance with these specifications and subject to the terms and conditions of the contract.

The contractor shall follow the Tree Inspectors directions for all State Route trimming.

Description of Work

The work consists of:

1. Trimming to achieve 14 foot clearance over streets; 8 foot clearance over sidewalks; to remove dead, decayed, and crossing limbs; to clear structures, minimum 5 foot clearance; and to lighten obvious heavy limbs as directed by the Tree Inspector. Excessive limb removal that promotes sucker growth is unacceptable. The requirement is to provide a complete general trim to each tree as called for in current Western Chapter International Society of Arboriculture Standards.
2. Removing dead, diseased, or structurally unsound trees, as directed by the Tree Inspector.
3. Repair or replacement of any damaged public or private property.

Work shall be performed in accordance with the following standards:

1. Lowering, by proper use of rope, any branch that could damage the property below or jeopardize ground personnel or public safety.
2. Stumps shall be cut to within 6" or less of the surrounding soil grade. A stump slab shall be provided the Tree Inspector for Tree Services study of tree growth if requested by inspector.

3. Each tree trimming or removal shall be completed within 2 days.

Equipment

All hand and power tools used in the performance of this work shall be subject to inspection and approval of the Tree Inspector. In general, standard tree trimming equipment shall be used and shall be maintained in a satisfactory condition at all times and in compliance with OSHA regulations. Saws shall be disinfected with Lysol (R), listerol, alcohol, kerosene or a solution of one part chlorine bleach in four parts water, which shall be applied to the tools to the point of run off. All wood shavings and sawdust must be cleaned off equipment prior to disinfecting. All tools shall be clean, sharp, in proper working order, and shall be checked for safety before each job. All trucks, chippers, and other heavy equipment shall be in good operating condition, well maintained, and in compliance with applicable laws and regulations.

Contractor shall supply as a minimum, but not be limited to, the following equipment.

1. For each crew:
 - a. Safety, tagline, and lowering ropes sufficient to work at heights required.
 - b. Power chainsaws of adequate size and power for the work to be accomplished to include one with 14" to 16" bar, two 21" bars, and one with 36" bar.
 - c. Hand saws, axes, and miscellaneous small tools for efficient performance.
 - d. All required safety warning devices, including, but not limited to, safety cones, barricades, flags, signs and any other traffic control or safety devices as required by City traffic engineer or Cal OSHA.
2. For total contract:
 - a. Each crew to be equipped with one tool truck with chip box to haul chips and one chipper.
 - b. One flatbed dump boom truck, a minimum of 1 1/2 ton capacity, boom 7,000 pounds, to haul limbs or trunk sections too large to pass through the chippers. Logs must be secured with one complete wrap of the chain or cable of sufficient strength prior to any lifting or loading.

Inspection

Contractor may contact Tree Inspector at 433-6345 during normal business hours during the course of the contract. The Tree Inspector shall inspect all removals and State Route trimming and must approve work performance prior to payment.

Special Conditions

All licenses, including a valid State of California contractor's license Category C27 or C61, insurance, etc., necessary to assume the legal responsibility for said work shall be acquired by the contractor to cover the liabilities which might be caused by said work.

All workers shall comply with State Compensation Safety Rules and must wear appropriate safety equipment at all times while on job. Adequate warning devices, barricades, guards, cones, etc., shall be supplied and used by the contractor to provide protection for the crews working, pedestrians, property residents, private property, parked cars and vehicular traffic concerned in the area. Contractor shall provide signs reading "No Parking--Tree to be Trimmed" as needed in advance of crews working in street trees. Work shall be scheduled and conducted in a cooperative manner in order to give the least possible interference with or annoyance to others. It shall be the responsibility of the contractor to work out any cooperative work schedule as necessary.

The normal work week will be Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. At direction of the Tree Inspector, contractor's crews may be required to work Tuesday through Saturday, 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and take Sunday and Monday off. This will be primarily in core City areas and other parts of the City where parked cars interfere with work.

All tree work requiring climbing of trees shall be suspended during inclement weather. No trimmings or debris shall be left overnight on any of the work sites. Upon completion of a specific area, the site shall be left in a clean and orderly condition. It shall be the responsibility of the contractor to repair any damages to adjacent property including shrubs, trees, or other growth, as well as structures along the route.

Personnel

All trimming work shall be done by qualified and trained persons with electrical line clearance certification when working within 10 feet of high voltage power lines and with a minimum of 2 years tree trimming experience. They shall be familiar with tree climbing and trimming work in general and trained to work in trees of any size. Qualified crew leaders shall be provided to oversee and direct the work of the crews.

Provision of two (2) crews for tree trimming work shall be made and these crews shall consist of three persons. Provision of one (1) removal crew in addition to the trimming crews for a total of three crews. Removal crew shall consist of five persons. All crew members shall be qualified for electrical line clearance work when working within 10 feet of high voltage power lines and one (1) crew member shall be designated as the supervisor.

Sufficient equipment shall be provided to avoid trimming or removal work stoppage by the crew, other than normal site clean-up.

In the event of termination, the City shall be liable only for payment of those services performed and accepted by the City prior to the date of termination and contractor and his surety shall be liable and assessed for any and all costs for the reprourement of the contract services.

REGULATIONS GOVERNING OPERATIONS
AS RELATED TO TRAFFIC MOVEMENT ON PUBLIC STREETS

Any operation on any highway within the city or county of Sacramento shall be handled individually with the applicable Traffic Engineering Department to determine work hours and traffic handling.

Operations on arterial streets within the city of Sacramento will be governed by the following:

1. No work will be permitted between the hours of 7:00 - 8:30 a.m. and 4:00 - 6:00 p.m.
2. Not more than one-half (1/2) of the street will be closed at any one time.
3. Parking on one or both sides of the street will be removed whenever more than one traffic lane is closed.
4. Sufficient advance warning by signs, barricades, flags, or cones will be given to insure a smooth flow of traffic around obstacles. One hundred feet (100') is suggested as the minimum distance.
5. Work equipment and vehicles will be placed so as to not unnecessarily block an additional traffic lane. They should be placed in the lane of traffic already blocked by excavation or open manhole. City vehicles or utility vehicles have no special parking privileges under the law except "while necessarily in use for construction or repair work."

In unusual or difficult cases of traffic interference, contact the applicable Traffic Engineer several days in advance of the operation in order that the proper arrangements can be made with the Police or Sheriff's Department and other interested agencies.

6. Any parking violations will be contractor's liability.

These inquiries are to be submitted at least 10 days prior to the bid opening date. Any interpretations by the City will be made in the form of a written amendment. The receipt of such an amendment must be acknowledged in accordance with the directions on the amendment. Oral explanations or instructions given before the award of the contract will not be binding.

Conference (Pre-Bid)

As a prospective Contractor, you are required to attend a pre-bid conference to be held at 10:30 a.m. on Wednesday, January 6, 1993, at City Corporation Center South, 5730 24th Street, Building 4, Sacramento, CA 95822. Failure to attend this conference will result in rejection of your bid.

Bid packages will be made available only through time and date of above announced Pre-Bid Conference. Subsequent addenda, if applicable, will be furnished only to those Contractors who attended the Pre-Bid Conference.

Conference (Pre-Award)

The apparent lowest responsible bidder shall attend a pre-award conference at a mutually acceptable time at which all requirements of these specifications will be reviewed. At that time, samples of forms, reports, etc., will be submitted by the Contractor for final approval.

Period of Contract

Work to commence within 30 days of award. All work to be completed in 180 calendar days following date of award.

Payment and Invoicing

Invoices, in triplicate, shall be mailed or delivered to City of Sacramento, 915 I Street, Sacramento, CA 95814, Attention: Accounts Payable. Invoices may be submitted for payment upon satisfactory completion of each category.

Multi-Year Contracts

If funds are not appropriated or otherwise made available to support continuation in any fiscal year succeeding the first fiscal year, the City shall have the right to terminate this contract and the Contractor is not entitled to recover any costs not incurred prior to termination.

Price Adjustment

No price changes are permitted during the first year of the contract. If the contract extends beyond one year, prices quoted may be made subject to adjustment.

Prevailing Wage

Any person performing labor in the execution of this contract shall be paid not less than the general prevailing rate of wages in private employment for similar work in the City of Sacramento.

In the event the Contractor pays any laborer or employee less than the established prevailing wage rate, the City will terminate the contract. In the event of such termination, Contractor shall be liable and assessed no less than the established rate per day per violation.

(See Appendix A - Prevailing Wage Scale)

Overtime

In the event overtime is required, the overtime rate shall be computed at the rate of _____ times the total hourly rate.

Computation of Labor Hours

The number of hours, for payment purposes, will be broken into quarter (1/4) hour segments. Time will commence upon the complete crew's arrival at the job site and terminate upon their departure from the job site.

Contract Representative

During performance of the contract, the City will be represented by Martin Fitch, Telephone (916) 433-6345.

Compliance With OSHA

The Contractor shall be responsible for strict compliance with all requirements of the California Occupational Safety and Health Act (OSHA) which are applicable to the work to be accomplished pursuant to this contract. OSHA shall be construed to include, but not be limited to, all applicable safety orders issued by the Division of Industrial Safety, State of California. In the event the Contractor, or any of his employees, shall observe any violation of OSHA in or on the premises on which the Contractor is to perform work pursuant to this contract, the Contractor shall immediately give written notice to the City of such violation.

Site Visit

All interested bidders are urged to visit the areas where the services are to be performed and familiarize themselves with all conditions that may affect the time or cost of performance. Failure to ascertain such conditions shall not be the basis of any subsequent claim or contract modification.

Protection of Existing Facilities

Contractor shall take every precaution to protect all public and private property during the performance of this contract. Any damages caused by Contractor's personnel or equipment will be promptly repaired to the condition existing before the damage or be replaced. All such costs for such repairs or replacement shall be the sole responsibility of the Contractor.

Default By Supplier

In case of default by supplier, the City reserves the right to procure the articles or services from other sources and to hold the supplier responsible for any excess costs occasioned to the City thereby.

Dismissal of Unsatisfactory Employees

The Contractor shall only furnish employees who are competent and skilled for work under this contract.

If, in the opinion of the City, an employee of the Contractor is incompetent or disorderly, refuses to perform in accordance with the terms and conditions of this contract, threatens or uses abusive language while on City property, or is otherwise unsatisfactory, that employee shall be removed from all work under this contract.

Quantities Unrestricted

The City is not limited to purchase all of its requirements from any contract resulting from this request.

CONTRACTOR'S STAFF

The contractor shall provide sufficient personnel to perform all work in accordance with the specifications set forth herein. All of the Contractor's maintenance personnel shall be supervised by a qualified, English speaking, Supervisor in the employ of the Contractor.

"NO BID" INSTRUCTIONS

Vendors not wishing to bid this particular requirement are encouraged to return the bid package marked "No Bid" with a brief statement explaining the reason for non-response: i. e., "not interested at this time", "not our field of manufacture/expertise", etc. This will enable us to maintain a current list of responsive bidders as well as verify receipt of the bid by your company.

PURCHASE ORDER

1. A Purchase Order will be issued to the Contractor on behalf of the City organization(s) who will be ordering items/services covered in the contract. The Purchase Order will be enclosed with the resulting contract or will be issued shortly thereafter, and will become an integral part of the resulting contract. Each Purchase Order will cite a specific dollar value to cover a particular item or specified period of time. If a contract is for a specific period of time and extends beyond the close of the City's fiscal year of June 30th, a second purchase order may be issued.
2. The Purchase Order does not supersede any provision of the resulting contract. Performance time and dates are determined solely by the contract, and any modification thereto.
3. Delivery of material and/or services are not to begin until receipt of the Purchase Order and/or other notification by the City Procurement Services Manager.

DRUG-FREE WORKPLACE POLICY

The City of Sacramento is committed to providing a safe workplace for its employees and citizens alike. An essential part of this commitment is keeping the work environment free from drugs. In 1989, to assist in the achievement of this end, the City established a Drug-Free Workplace Policy.

As a contractor doing business with the City, it is expected that your firm will also implement a drug-free policy that informs your employees of the dangers and prohibition of drug abuse and that you will join with the City in maintaining a drug-free workplace.

If, in the performance of work under this contract, any employee of the Contractor exhibits unacceptable behavior that may be related to use of drugs or alcohol, the City reserves the right to discuss the employee's behavior with the Contractor. If the unacceptable behavior persists, the City may require that the employee be removed from all work under this contract.

TERMINATION

Whenever, in the opinion of the Purchasing Agent, the said service is not satisfactory, the Contractor shall be advised of the reasons. If the Contractor fails to correct the unsatisfactory conditions within 5 days, the Purchasing Agency may declare this contract terminated and contract with another supplier. It shall be understood and agreed that the contract may be terminated by the City upon thirty days written notice.

Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary herein, the City shall have no obligation to give more than two notices of unsatisfactory performance in any calendar year. In the event two such notices of unsatisfactory performance are given in any calendar year, and in the event that Contractor(s) shall again fail to satisfactorily perform services pursuant to this Contract, the City may thereupon terminate this contract immediately.

The Contractor and/or surety will be liable and assessed for any and all costs for the reprocurement of the contract services.
