

ORDINANCE NO. 525 , FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 52 $\frac{1}{2}$  OF ORDINANCE NO. 18, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED SEPTEMBER 22nd, 1921, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR LICENSING AND REGULATING THE CARRYING ON OF CERTAIN PROFESSIONS, TRADES, CALLINGS AND OCCUPATIONS; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE AND MAKING THIS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE, TO TAKE EFFECT OCTOBER 1ST, 1921." MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 399, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED NOVEMBER 30, 1928.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. Section 52 $\frac{1}{2}$  of Ordinance No. 18, Fourth Series, passed September 22nd, 1921, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 52 $\frac{1}{2}$ . CHARACTER ANALYSIS. For every person who carries on, practices or professes to practice the business or profession of character analysis, and who demands or receives a fee for the exercise or exhibition of his or her art therein, directly or indirectly, either as a gift, donation, or otherwise, or who gives an exhibition thereof at any place where an admission fee is charged, \$600.00 per quarter.


SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby made an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately, said emergency being that the State Fair is shortly to be held in Sacramento and it is anticipated that many persons will apply for licenses under this section, whereas, in truth and in fact, they are practicing the business covered by Section 52 of said Ordinance No. 18, fourth series, which carries a \$600.00 per quarter license.

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 399, fourth series, passed November 30, 1928, is hereby repealed.
