**AN ORDINANCE ADDING SECTION 9.32.180 TO CHAPTER 9.32 OF TITLE 9
OF THE SACRAMENTO CITY CODE TO REQUIRE REPORTING STOLEN OR
LOST FIREARMS**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO

SECTION 1.

Section 9.32.180 is added to Chapter 9.32 of Title 9 of the Sacramento City Code as follows:

9.32.180 Reporting of stolen and/or lost firearms required.

It is unlawful for any person who owns or possesses a firearm to knowingly or negligently fail to report the theft or loss of such firearm to the Sacramento Police Department within forty-eight (48) hours of the time he/she knew or should have known the firearm has been stolen or lost, when either the owner or possessor resides in the city, or the theft or loss of the firearm occurs in the city. As used in this section, "firearm" means any device, designed to be used as a weapon or modified to be used as a weapon, which expels a projectile through a barrel by the force of an explosion or other form of combustion. Any person violating this section is guilty of a misdemeanor.
