SUBJECT: Safety Improvements at Airport Little League (LD91)

SUMMARY

This report recommends that the FY 1988-89 Capital Improvement budget be amended to transfer funds in the amount of \$4,000 from the Quimby Act Reserve Fund to the Parks and Community Services Department Capital Improvement Project (LD91) for the improvement of the Airport Little League site.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Airport Little League leases approximately 6.5 acres of park land from the Parks and Community Services Department on both sides of 24th Street at 47th Avenue and Hogan Drive. The FY 1987-88 Capital Improvement Program included \$13,000 to provide for improvements at the site such as perimeter fencing along Hogan Drive and the repair of bleachers. During construction, it was discovered that the electrical service was defective and posed a serious safety hazard to the facilities and the participants. The required electrical repairs and increases in related indirect costs necessitate an increase in funding of \$4,000.

Funds are available in the Quimby Act Reserve Fund to make electrical repairs at the Airport Little League site. The Quimby Act requires that fees collected from subdivision developers be expended for park improvements to serve the community in which they were collected.

FINANCIAL DATA

The estimated cost of providing safety improvements at Airport Little League is \$4,000. Funds in the amount of \$4,000 are available in the FY 1988-89 Quimby Reserve Fund to transfer to this project so that the bid process can be initiated.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Budget and Finance Committee approve this report and refer it to the full City Council for action. Further, it is recommended that the City Council, by resolution, authorize the transfer of \$4,000 from the Quimby Act Reserve Fund to the Airport Little League improvement project.
