OLD SACRAMENTO BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT AREA RE:

Honorable Members in Session:

SUMMARY

November 25, 1980 is the date set for the public hearing to determine whether the Old Sacramento Business Improvement Area should be disestablished. The City Council is required to disestablish the Area unless at the hearing it appears that a protest against disestablishment is made by a majority of the businesses in the Area.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

A petition in opposition to the Old Sacramento Business Improvement Area has been filed with the City Council, signed by a majority of the owners and representatives of businesses in the Under City Code Section 23.731 the Council, upon the filing Area. of such a petition, is required to adopt a resolution of intention to disestablish the business improvement area and to set a public hearing on the matter. On October 28, 1980, the Council adopted Resolution No. 80-719 declaring an intention to disestablish the Area and setting a hearing on November 25, 1980. Under the City Code, the Council is required to disestablish the Area, unless at the hearing it appears that protest against disestablishment is made by a majority of the businesses in the Area. In the event a petition protesting disestablishment is filed with the City Council on November 25, 1980, the Council may wish to continue the hearing to allow the Revenue and Collections Officer to report back on the validity of the signatures and the extent of the protest.

A copy of the hearing notice for this hearing is attached as well as a copy of Resolution No. 80-719.

Dear Mr. Medema:

We are in receipt of the draft "Notice of Hearing" of the petition to disestablish the Old Sacramento Business Improvement Area. We appreciate the opportunity to review the Notice and to suggest alternative wording.

In regard to the latter, it is, and was at the City Council meeting of October 28, 1980, the position of this organization that:

(a) The subject City Ordinance No. 4399 requires verification of signatures on a petition to disestablish prior to the scheduling of a hearing;

(b) In order to verify that the signatories represent a majority, an accurate list of the <u>total</u> entities must be established;

(c) To establish the total, the term "businesses" as used in the ordinance must be defined to ascertain if it means "business licenses", "business license holders", or simply "business establishments".

The import of (b) and (c) are that: Many persons hold more than one license and have signed the petition in opposition once for each license; several license holders do not appear on the most recent list provided by the City; and, several "business establishments" are not licensed. In view of the foregoing, we continue to maintain that verification cannot have properly taken place and that the hearing is prematurely scheduled.

We would therefore suggest that if the Council is determined to proceed, the Notice at least be amended, at the beginning of the second paragraph, to read:

> "A petition in opposition to the District has been submitted to the City Council. It is the opinion of James Jackson, City Attorney, that it is signed by a majority of the owners and representatives of businesses in the Old Sacramento Business Improvement Area".

Our concern in this matter is in part due to the fact that our Board of Directors has determined that, at our general membership meeting which will be held in December, amendments to the fee structure of the B.I.A. could be considered and voted upon, and that the concerns that gave rise to the petition to disestablish might be resolved.



The owners of the Mary & Molly Shop, Mrs. Mary Keller, and Mrs. Molly Doucette, have discussed the proposed OSBIA with me, and have asked that I write and comment on the pending resolution to disestablish it. The Mary & Molly Shop has been doing business in Old Sacramento in excess of 10 years. It is one of the oldest independent retail shops in Old Sacramento. Its owners continue to be quite concerned about the development of the business climate in the area, and in the preservation of the independence and welfare of its retail merchants.

In reviewing the history of the development of a proposal to establish the OSBIA and listening to discussions by groups who are presently opposing, and favoring it, I have reached the following conclusions:

- The funds raised by the proposed tax on the merchants would be placed in the hands of a merchants' association which presently represents a minority of the merchants, as evidenced by numerical attendance at its meetings, and the pending petition by a majority of the merchants opposing the association's desire to establish and OSBIA.
- 2. The minority group, controlling the promotional funds, would be in a position to independently determine the type and character of promotional activities. In the past they have favored certain activities which are not well received by many merchants and members of the public, but appeared to be thoroughly enjoyed by those

> involved at the expense of the others. I refer, of course, to the so called "shoot outs";strong opposing opinions presently exist among the merchants as to whether this type of promotional activity does result in business improvement.

- 3. The overwhelming majority of the merchants do not want the proposed OSBIA, as evidenced by their filed petition. It is my understanding that, with more time, an even larger number of merchants' signatures would have been obtained on it.
 - 4. Unfortunately procedural problems have delayed a vote by the City Council on the pending resolution. However, I understand our City Attorney has advised the Council that procedural requirements have now been met, and, hopefully, the Council will vote on the matter at the noticed hearing on 11/25/80.
 - 5. I would feel that only those persons or firms having actual business licenses to operate in Old Sacramento should be entitled to determine whether the proposed additional tax should be levied upon them to establish the proposed OSBIA, and that, despite the efforts of a vocal minority to push it through, the opposition of the majority of the merchants should be respected.

I am sure the Council is aware of the potential for Old Sacramento to become a national historic site, and the need for concern and attention by the Council during its present formative period. It is my own feeling that there is not sufficient justification, or need, for the OSBIA in its proposed form. Therefore it is my hope that the Council will vote in favor of the pending resolution to disestablish it.
