SUBJECT: Revocable Encroachment Permit - Maurice I. Zumot

and S. H. Salman

SUMMARY

Maurice I. Zumot and S. H. Salman have applied for a revocable encroachment permit for the purpose of constructing landscaping planters. The City Engineer recommends that the permit be granted.

BACKGROUND

The area for which this request is being made consists of an area 3' wide along the northerly and easterly property lines (excepting driveways) on County Assessor's Parcel Nos. 61-023-10 & 11. Said parcel is on the southwest corner of the intersection of Power Inn Road and 14th Avenue.

RECOMMENDATION

The City Engineer recommends that the attached resolution be passed granting a revocable encroachment permit to Maurice I. Zumot and S. H. Salman in the area and for the purpose outlined above.



RESOLUTION GRANTING REVOCABLE ENCROACHMENT TO:
Maurice I. Zumot and S. H. Salman
BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:
That a revocable encroachment permit for the purpose of constructing landscaping planters
is hereby granted to Maurice I. Zumot and S. H. Salman , whose
address is as follows: 3000 Handle Way, Sacramento .
The encroachment area is described as follows:
An area adjacent to Permittee's property. An area 3' wide along the northerly and easterly property lines (excepting driveways) on County Assessor's Parcel Numbers 61-023-10 & 11. Said parcel is on the southwest corner of the intersection of Power Inn Road and 14th Avenue.
This permit is granted subject to the "General Provisions -
Revocable Encroachment Permit", which were adopted by the City Council
in Resolution No. 77-611 dated October 4, 1977, and the hereinafter
specified special conditions, if any. This permit shall be effective only
after the applicant files with the Department of Finance of the City of
Sacramento, the insurance certificates required by the General Provisions.
SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- 1. Provision 21 "Liability Insurance" is hereby waived.
- Permittee shall comply with requirements of the City Planning Dept., the Building Inspections Dept., and the City Sign Ordinance.
- 3. 4' planter is required on owner's property or a Planning Commission variance.
