Recognizing the Fox & Goose Public House On the Occasion of their 30th Anniversary

WHEREAS, the Fox & Goose Public House opened its doors on January 15, 1975, patterned after the original Fox & Goose located on the scenic Moors of northern England, which has been in operation for over two hundred years; and

WHEREAS, founders William and Denise Dalton wanted to capture the traditional qualities of this English pub, while adding an atmosphere all its own; and

WHEREAS, the Fox and Goose is housed in a warehouse built in 1913 that was once the Fuller Paint and Glass Company and was one of the first places in Sacramento to offer a wide variety of popular British and European beers on draught, and quickly became the gathering place for those seeking the camaraderie of a true pub, as well as a fine eating establishment; and

WHEREAS, the Fox and Goose has consistently won numerous awards, including "Best Breakfast", "Best Open Mike Night", "Best Beer Selection", "Best Brunch" and more as voted by the readers of the Sacramento Magazine and Sacramento News and Review, and is also featured in many travel books including "Frommer's California with Kids" and "Northern California Best Places"; and

WHEREAS, the Fox and Goose prides itself on its devotion to giving back to the community and has donated to Sacramento Food Bank, Student Buddy Program, American Cancer Society, Western Service Workers, SSPCA, Sacramento Zoological Society, Friends of the River and many others; and

WHEREAS, the Fox and Goose has been a pioneer in restaurant recycling and was recently awarded the prestigious WRAP award from the California Integrated Waste Management Board; and

WHEREAS, Bill and Denise's daughter, Allyson, purchased the business in December 1995 and has continued to operate the business with her parents' devotion to quality, quantity and consistency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Sacramento, that we do hereby congratulate the Fox and Goose Public House on the occasion of their 30th Anniversary and do hereby commend them for their continued service to our community, earning great respect as a favorite local eatery.
