SUBJECT: Storm Drainage Sump No. 144 Modifications (PN:WC36) - Project
Approval and Bid Advertisement

SUMMARY

Plans and specifications for this project have been prepared. Approval of the plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids is recommended.

BACKGROUND

Sump 144, which is located just north of I-80 between Rio Linda Boulevard and Marysville Boulevard, sustained considerable damage to the electrical system during the floods of 1986. This project will raise the central building above flood level and provide electrical modifications to correct the problem areas.

A Negative Declaration for this project was filed with the County Clerk of the County of Sacramento on March 28, 1988. The engineer's estimated construction cost is \$51,300.

FINANCIAL DATA

Sufficient funds are available for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$81,800. The current budget is \$85,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from the Storm Drainage Fund (425). The funds available for this project amount to \$71,500 as of January 17, 1989.

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A non-refundable fee of \$25 will be charged for each set of plans and specifications to cover reproduction costs.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

There are no policy considerations associated with this item.

MBE/WBE EFFORTS

Plans and specifications will be forwarded to nineteen (19) plan rooms and construction services for publications and use by the construction industry in Northern California. The list includes four (4) organizations directly involved with MBE and WBE contractors.

RECOMMENDATION


It is recommended that the City Council approve the plans and specifications for this project and authorize the City Clerk to advertise for bids to be received on February 28, 1989.
