

## RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING FUNDS FOR THE SUTTERVILLE ROAD/SPRR DRAIN PROJECT

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

1. Bids have been received for the Sutterville Road/SPRR Drain Project and additional funds are needed to award the contract.
2. The Capital Improvement Program is hereby amended by transferring \$27,000 from the Miscellaneous Drainage Improvements Fund (425-500-WA51-4820) to the Sutterville Road/SPRR Drain Project (425-500-WA21-4820) for the purpose stated in Paragraph 1 above.

SUBJECT: Sutterville Road/SPRR Drain (PN:WA21) - Resolution for Fund Transfer  
and Contract Award

SUMMARY

This project has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and additional funds are needed to award the contract. The Budget and Finance Committee considered the fund transfer at their meeting on October 13, 1987.

BACKGROUND

The 36 inch storm drain crossing under Sutterville Road just west of the old Southern Pacific Railroad right-of-way requires replacement to correct a drainage problem. The City has received an agreement and grant of easement from the State of California Department of Parks and Recreation, the current owner of the railroad right-of-way, to replace the portion of the storm drain which lies within the railroad right-of-way.

On August 11, 1987, the City Council approved the plans and specifications for this project. Bids were received and opened by the City Clerk on September 1, 1987. The bids received were:

Placer Paving, Inc.	\$37,290
Jerry Gavrilko Co.	47,394

The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$18,600. The estimated project completion date is December 15, 1987. Although the low bid of Placer Paving Inc. is twice the amount of the engineer's estimate, it is believed to be the best bid available at this time.

FINANCIAL

Additional funds are needed to award the contract for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs is \$67,000. The current budget is \$40,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from 1965 Flood and Drainage Funds. It is proposed that the needed, additional \$27,000 be transferred from the Miscellaneous Drainage Improvements account to this project.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council approve the transfer of funds by adoption of the attached resolution, accept the low bid of Placer Paving, Inc. in the amount of \$37,290 and award the contract.
