

ORDINANCE NO. 442, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO GRADE AND DRAIN THE GROUNDS AT THE MUNICIPAL AIRPORT WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:


Section 1. The City Engineer is hereby authorized and directed to make contract for grading the draining the grounds at the municipal airport without first advertising for bids, such course having been recommended by the City Manager, at a cost not to exceed \$2,500.00.

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately, such emergency existing because there is not sufficient time to advertise for bids and award a contract for the doing of such work to enable same to be completed before the very wet season arrives, and it further appearing that approximately ten per cent of the cost of doing said work can be saved in this manner.
