SUBJECT: PRIVATELY OPERATED STREET SWEEPING PROGRAM FOR THE
FRANKLIN VILLA #2 APARTMENT COMPLEX NEIGHBORHOOD

SUMMARY

This report recommends the posting of parking prohibitions in the Franklin Villa #2 neighborhood for the purpose of a privately operated street sweeping program.

BACKGROUND

In May of 1986, the City Council approved the posting of "No Parking" regulations in the Franklin Villa #1 neighborhood to facilitate weekly street sweeping by the Homeowner's Association on a private basis. The success of that program has prompted the Franklin Villa Homeowner's Association to request that the City post "No Parking" regulations in the Franklin Villa #2 neighborhood. Under this program the street sweeping itself will be performed by the Homeowner's Association weekly on a private basis, except for the regularly scheduled once a month street sweeping service that is now provided by the City's Solid Waste Division.

Enforcement of the "No Parking" regulations will be provided by the City Police Department by complaint and on a priority basis only. This area is outside of the boundaries for enforcement by the City Parking Operations.

Pursuant to Section 25.103 of the Sacramento City Code, all of these regulations must be adopted by resolution of the City Council because the area is located outside of the Central Traffic District. A resolution for this purpose is attached.

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
FINANCIAL DATA





A RESOLUTION TO PROHIBIT PARKING AT CERTAIN TIMES ON STREETS WITHIN THE FRANKLIN VILLA NO. 2 RESIDENTIAL COMPLEX

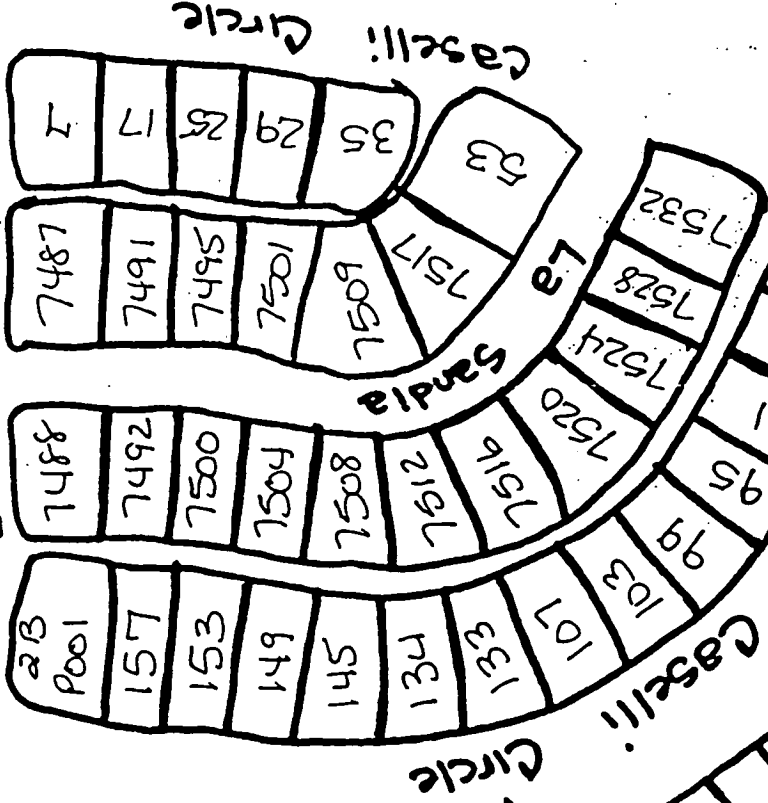
BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

Pursuant to section 25.103 of the City Code of the City of Sacramento, parking shall be prohibited on Mondays between 8:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. on the following street segments.

- Franklin Blvd. - West side between G Parkway and Caselli Circle
- El Mango Way - Both sides between G Parkway and Caselli Circle
- G Parkway - South side between Franklin Boulevard and Morrison Creek
- El Limon Court - Both sides of entire street
- Caselli Circle - Both sides of north loop
- North side of south loop
- La Sandia Way - Both sides of entire street
