SUBJECT: Haggin Oaks Golf Course Pressure Water Well Tank (JN:2116, PN:0A26) -
Project Approval and Bid Advertisement

SUMMARY

Plans and specifications have been prepared for this project. Approval of the plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids is recommended.

BACKGROUND

This project consists of adding a pressurized water well tank to the existing Well No. 52, which is located in Haggin Oaks Golf Course. The new water tank will supply water for the sports complex. The project is a portion of the overall program to update the irrigation and potable water system at the Haggin Oaks Golf Course. The engineer's estimated construction cost is \$32,000.

FINANCIAL

Sufficient funds are available for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$38,000. The current budget is \$158,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from Golf Funds. There are \$137,000 available for the project.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council approve the plans and specifications and authorize the City Clerk to advertise for bids to be received on August 12, 1986
