
**ADOPTION OF THE NORTHGATE SURVEY AREA, INITIATING  
REDEVELOPMENT PLAN ADOPTION PROCEEDINGS**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF  
SACRAMENTO:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Sacramento hereby finds and determines that a feasibility study was completed in June 2000 for that portion of the City of Sacramento shown on Attachment I to this resolution (the "Survey Area") and was determined that a redevelopment project or projects within said area is feasible.


Section 2. The Survey Area is hereby designated as a redevelopment survey area, as defined in the California Community Redevelopment Law (Health and Safety Code Section 33000 *et seq.*), for determination of the feasibility of adopting a redevelopment plan for all or a portion of the Survey Area.

Section 3. The Executive Director is authorized and directed to study the feasibility of a redevelopment project or projects within the Survey Area and to return with a recommendation regarding the possible selection of a redevelopment project area and formulation of a preliminary plan.
