SUBJECT: Cold Planing City Streets at Various Locations - Project Approval and Bid Advertisement

SUMMARY

Specifications for this project have been prepared and authorization to advertise for bids is recommended.

BACKGROUND

There are various locations around the City where small areas of pavement require repair, but must be cold planed before City forces can refurbish the asphalt surface. Since the cold planing can be performed during inclement weather when other street repair work is not possible, the contractor will be utilized on an on-call basis for a maximum of 160 hours to be accomplished before March 15, 1986.

FINANCIAL

The City Council has approved in the Public Works Street Maintenance Operating Budget sufficient funds to cover the cost of this project. The estimated cost for the project is \$20,000.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the specifications be approved and that the City Clerk be authorized to advertise for bids to be received on January 7, 1986.
