SUBJECT: Purchase of One (1) Each Custom Equipped Patrol Boat

### SUMMARY

The Sacramento Police Department has a current requirement for the purchase of one (1) each patrol boat to be utilized when patrolling the Sacramento waterways. The source of funding for this requirement is a grant from the state of California. However, since there is a requirement that the funds be expended within a specified time period and since delivery lead time is very crucial, it is recommended that the City Council suspend formal competitive bidding for the purchase of this requirement.

### BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Sacramento Police Department would like to put this unit into operation at the upcoming Water Festival which is scheduled for the beginning of July 1984. Informal bids were therefore solicited; however, only one (1) bid was received.

Based on the review and evaluation of the proposal received as well as the fact the unit required is very specialized and must be custom equipped, the Police Department has determined that it would be in the best interests of the City to suspend formal competitive bidding for the purchase of this requirement and to award a contract to Hoig's Marine, the lowest responsive and responsible bidder in the total amount of \$31,588 plus license fees.

### FINANCIAL DATA

The total cost for the purchase of this requirement is \$31,588 plus license fees. The source of funding for this purchase is a grant from the state of California.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that, pursuant to Section 57.401(c) of the Sacramento City Code, the City Council adopt a resolution suspending formal competitive bidding for the purchase of one (1) each patrol boat and authorize the City Manager to execute the necessary contract with Hoig's Marine, 901 Howe Avenue, Sacramento, California 95825, in the total amount of \$31,588 plus license fees.
