Subject: Recommendation of Bid Award for Street Light Conversion Program, Phase V

SUMMARY:

The subject project, as a part of the City's Capital Improvement Program has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and the Director of Public Works hereby recommends bid award.

BACKGROUND:

On June 12, 1984, the City Council approved plans and specifications for Street Light Conversion Program, Phase V and bids were received and opened by the City Clerk in the Council Chambers on July 3, 1984. Bids received are as follows:

Richard A. Heaps Electrical Contractor	\$29,449.62
Mah-Han Electric Inc., dba M & M Electric	\$29,925.00
Foley-PMI, Inc.	\$29,925.00
Steiny and Company, Inc.	\$30,523.50
Smith Electric Supply	\$30,609.00

The subject project represents the fifth year of a ten year program to convert existing fluorescent and mercury vapor street light fixtures to high pressure sodium, increasing lighting efficiency at a lower operating cost. The current phase of the conversion program will replace luminaires at 75 locations throughout the City. The engineer's construction estimate for this project was \$23,940.00. Although the low bid of Richard A. Heaps Electrical Contractor, in the amount of \$29,449.62, is 23.01% over the engineer's estimate, we feel it is the best bid obtainable.


FINANCIAL:
