

## **RESOLUTION 2026-0028**

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

February 10, 2026

### **Establish Capital Improvement Project and Budgetary Adjustment for the HSIP 12 Traffic Signal Improvements Project (T15265100)**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. The HSIP 12 Traffic Signal Improvements Project (T15265100) will improve seventeen signalized intersections throughout the City through installation of new traffic signal heads and modifications of existing signal heads to include retro-reflective tape. These improvements will increase visibility at intersections and improve the signal hardware.
- B. The City has been awarded \$950,904 from the State Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) for the construction of this project, however preliminary engineering, environmental clearance, and design must be completed before these funds can be authorized.
- C. The establishment of a Capital Improvement Project and approval of related budgetary adjustment for the HSIP 12 Traffic Signal Improvements Project (T15265100) are necessary to begin preliminary engineering and environmental clearance on the project.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

##### **SECTION 1.**

The HSIP 12 Traffic Signal Improvements Project (T15265100) is established as a new Capital Improvement Project.

##### **SECTION 2.**

The City Manager or designee is authorized to transfer \$200,000 (Major Street Construction, Fund 2007) from the expenditure budget of the State and Federal Grant Match Project (T15007200) to the expenditure budget of the HSIP 12 Traffic Signal Improvements Project (T15265100) and resetting the administrative authority for the State and Federal Grant Match Project (T15007200).
