SUBJECT: Pedestrian Walkway on 63rd Street (PN:TC11) - Contract Award

SUMMARY

This project has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and contract award is recommended.

BACKGROUND

This project will reconstruct the existing pedestrian walkway on 63rd Street between Elder Creek Road and Lemon Hill Avenue and rehabilitate the existing bridge over Morrison Creek. The existing walkway and bridge are both in an advanced state of deterioration and this project will provide greater safety for the children walking to Will C. Wood Middle School.

On January 26, 1988, the City Council approved the plans and specifications for this project. Bids were received and opened by the City Clerk on February 16, 1988. The bids received were:

Hosea-Younger General Contractors	\$ 81,601.30
Western Engineering Contractors	92,754.00
Granite Construction Co.	101,934.00

The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$97,000. The estimated project completion date is July 15, 1988.

FINANCIAL

Additional funds are needed for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs is \$124,000. The current budget is \$110,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from

RECOMMENDATION


It is recommended that the City Council accept the low bid of Hosea-Younger General Contractors in the amount of \$81,601.30, and award the contract.


