SUMMARY

An application has been received for water service outside the city limits. Staff recommends approval of this service.

BACKGROUND

Section 47.41 of the City Code provides for water service outside the city limits only by Council approval. The attached application has been received from Mr. Richard A. Prater, owner of a parcel at 5736 Stockton Boulevard. This parcel will be used for a small business activity.

The water system in this area was purchased by the City from Southern California Water Company in 1963, since the system was almost entirely within the City limits. The parcel in question lies within the original area franchised to the Southern California Water Company by the Public Utilities Commission. This means that the company had the exclusive right and obligation to serve property within the franchise area.

The Public Utilities Commission approved the sale of this system to the City. One of the conditions contained in the approval document states:

"The City of Sacramento will be subject to all legal claims for water service which might have been enforced against the SELLER, including such claims as may exist in territory outside of the City limits of the City of Sacramento."

Staff has always interpreted this to require that the city provide service to any property within the franchise area. The attached map shows the parcel in question. There is very little area left that falls into this category, being outside the city and within the original franchise area.

FINANCIAL There will be negligible financial impact. The owner will be required to extend the water main and service line.



RECOMMENDATION


Staff recommends that the city provide water service to the parcel in question, after the owner has complied with normal conditions of main extension and plumbing code.

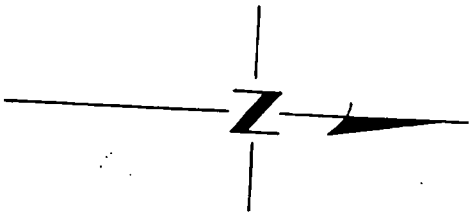

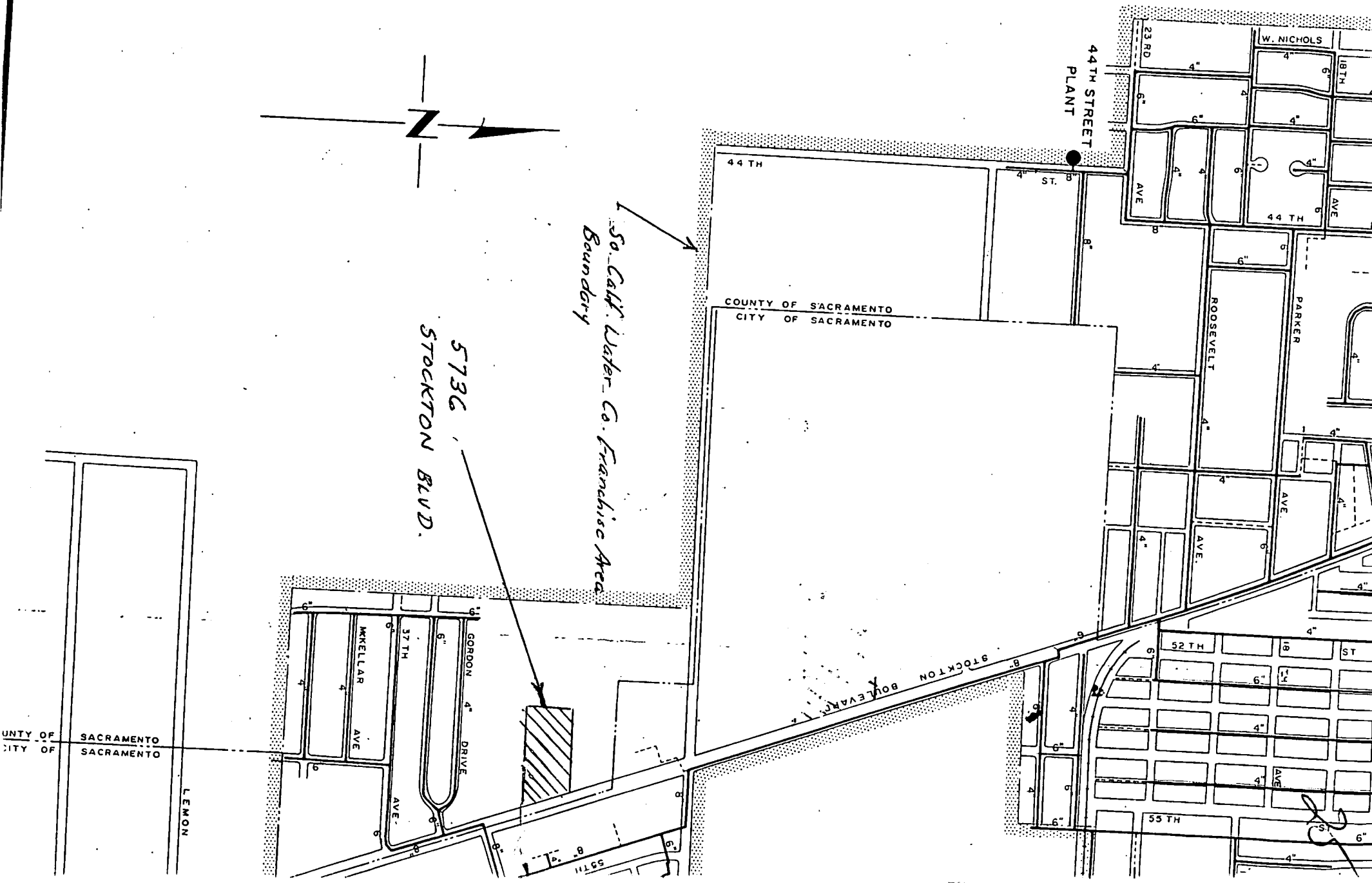
