

ORDINANCE NO. 520, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE I, SECTION 1, OF ORDINANCE NO. 5, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JUNE 30, 1921, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING THE OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES TO ASSIST THE CITY CONTROLLER IN THE PERFORMANCE OF HIS DUTIES," CONSISTING OF AN ASSESSOR-COLLECTOR TO BE IN CHARGE OF THE DIVISION OF REVENUE AND COLLECTIONS, AN AUDITOR TO BE IN CHARGE OF THE DIVISION OF BUDGETS AND ACCOUNTS, A PURCHASING AGENT TO BE IN CHARGE OF THE PURCHASING DIVISION, AND SUCH CLERKS, INVESTIGATORS, STENOGRAPHERS AND OTHER EMPLOYEES AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO CARRY ON THE WORK CONNECTED WITH THE CITY MANAGEMENT AND CONTROL IN THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE; CREATING A DIVISION OF REVENUE AND COLLECTIONS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE; CREATING A DIVISION OF BUDGETS AND ACCOUNTS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE; CREATING A PURCHASING DIVISION IN THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND PRESCRIBING THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE PURCHASING AGENT; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith AND DECLARING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY ON THE DATE OF ITS PASSAGE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:


SECTION 1. Article I, Section 1, of Ordinance No. 5, Fourth Series, passed June 30, 1921, is hereby amended to read as follows:-

ARTICLE I.


SECTION 1. To assist the City Controller in the performance of his duties in the supervision of the Department of Finance, there shall be appointed an Assessor-Collector who shall be in charge of the Division of Revenue and Collections, an Auditor who shall be in charge of the Division of Budgets and Accounts, a Purchasing Agent who shall be in charge of the Purchasing Division, an additional Chief Deputy who shall be an assistant to the City Controller and not in charge of a division, and such clerks, investigators, stenographers and other employees as the City Council may by ordinance or resolution determine to be necessary to carry on the work connected with the city management and control in the said Department of Finance.
