APPOINTMENT

Eleven (11) members as follows:

- A. Five (5) members appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by City Council. Of the five members;
 1. One (1) member shall be a practicing artist;
 2. One (1) member shall be an arts administrator.
- B. Five (5) members appointed by the Board of Supervisors. Of the five members:
 1. One member shall be a practicing artist;
 2. One member shall be an arts administrator.
- C. One (1) member appointed jointly by the Mayors of Folsom, Isleton and Galt

Note: The fields of art which may be considered in the appointment of practicing artist and arts administrator include architecture, the environmental arts, visual arts, performing arts and the literary arts.

TERM:

Three (3) year term. Two (2) full 3-year terms limit applies, but member shall be eligible for reappointment to the Commission after two years have past after the prior date served on the commission.

MEETING INFO:

Monthly, on the third Wednesday, at 1:30 p.m., SMAC office, 2030 Del Paso Blvd. First regular meeting of the month of June of each year shall be the Annual Meeting of the Commission.
